

Sometimes we are mocked for our faith, dismissed as ignorant or superstitious; but God is not created in our imagination.

Rather it is God's gift of our imagination and intelligence which allows us to contemplate our own existence, the events of salvation history, and our relationship with God and his Creation, through personal revelation and the illumination of many great thinkers - historians, philosophers, Saints, theologians, and scientists.



Did you know? Catholic priest Georges Lemaître created the **Big Bang**Theory in 1927 to describe the origins of the universe.

The Bible's **Creation Story**, though, is not science, or history, but began as a Babylonian creation myth which was changed by the writer to reveal God as one, all-powerful and benevolent Creator of good.

John 20:19-31

It was evening on the day Jesus rose from the dead, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear of the Jews. Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." But Thomas, who was called the Twin, one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe." After eight days his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out

Difficulty is not Doubt

Faith is a decision to submit to God. When doubt becomes a *decision* not to, we sin.

Struggling with a Church teaching is not a sin.

We all struggle to live our faith! Our response to God's love and mercy, though, compels us to do more than disagree. In the garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26), Jesus shows our response to struggle is prayer, actively seeking and submitting to God's will, and calling on the support of our faith community.

After seeing the Risen Christ, Thomas acclaims,

My Lord and my God!

What a perfect expression of faith!

When we receive the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist, we are touching the Risen Christ who is physically present to us.

In the quiet moments after we have received Communion, we silently offer our thanksgiving for the sacrifice of Jesus and the gift of our salvation. What better way than to offer this simple prayer, "My Lord and my God!"

your hand and put in it my side. Do not doubt but believe." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book. But these are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

What is Jesus telling me?

Jesus says to Thomas, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to

believe." Does Jesus insist that Thomas believe without seeing and leave him in his doubt; or does Jesus come to him too?

Why do I believe in God? How did I first receive his gift of faith?

Where can I see or hear God now?
Where does He come to me?

Faith Seeking Understanding

CCC 154. Believing is possible only by grace and the interior helps of the Holy Spirit. But it is no less true that believing is an authentically human act. Trusting in God and cleaving to the truths he has revealed are contrary neither to human freedom nor to human reason ...

CCC 158. "Faith seeks understanding": it is intrinsic to faith that a believer desires to know better the One in whom he has put his faith and to understand better what He has revealed ...


