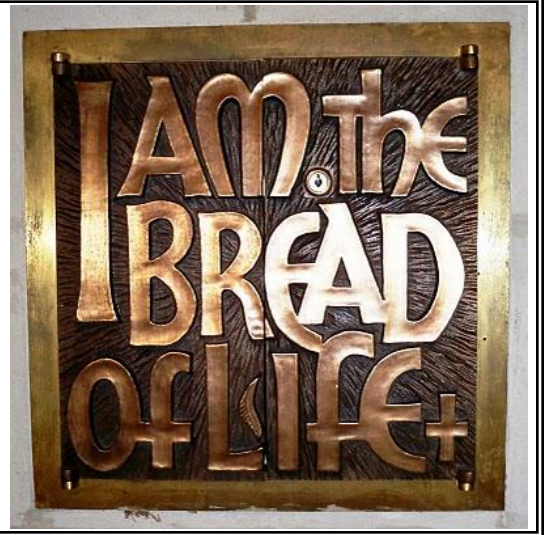

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

In a week or two, the parish will replace the traditional votive light stands beside the statues of Mary and St. Joseph and replace them with two new electronic votive light stands. There are many reasons for this change: fire regulations, insurance compliance, clean up time, environmental concerns, waste issues and a few close calls. The new system will be very easy to use. After depositing your offering you can take an electronic votive light from the tray and place it in the desired slot. The electronic light will remain lit for three hours and go off by itself.

Our Confirmation program will begin on Tuesday, September 18th at 6 p.m. with an information meeting for all parents and candidates (this also includes the St. Joseph's students) in the parish hall. Candidates not attending St. Joseph's Catholic School will meet every Tuesday beginning on September 25th from 6 to 7:30pm.

Our First Reconciliation/Communion program will begin on Tuesday, September 25th at 6:00 p.m. with an information meeting for all parents and children (this also includes the St. Joseph's Catholic students) in the parish hall. Children not attending St. Joseph Catholic School will meet every Tuesday beginning on October 2nd from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. We are looking for someone who would be willing to teach this class or be willing to help out.

Family Nights will begin on Wednesday, September 26th at 5:30 pm and will run every second Wednesday thereafter. (Sept. 26th, Oct. 10th, Oct. 24th, Nov. 7th, Nov. 21st and Dec. 5th) Family Nights begins with a shared supper, a time of song and prayer, stories and teaching, a family activity and devotionals. 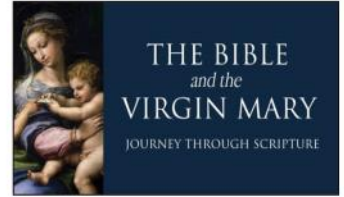
