DivorceCare for Kids is a special group to the help children heal from the hurt caused by the separation or



for us to be proactive, to purposely be developing our virtues so that we feel empowered before the unfolding of world events. There is that great line that goes; "Better to light a single candle than to curse the darkness."

The fact is, we are promised that God wants to multiply even our smallest acts of kindnesses 30, 60 and even 100 fold and so we should actively and consciously work to create the kind of world that we are praying for. Which is why we here at St. Charles Garnier have so many outreaches to help us to grow in the virtues of love and service.
