You all may be wondering how Father Bart made out with his trip up the mountain last Monday in support of St. Vincent de Paul's Invincible Housing project. Fact is, he did extremely well!!! 4 hr. 10 min on the ascent to the Big White village, 2 hr. 30 min on the way home! Chris Collins, of Okanagan Peak Performance, rode all the way up with Father.

St. Charles Vincentians and assorted others gave him a good send off, with many attending Mass celebrated by Father and Bishop Greg before Father Bart shoved off... He rode 45 km until dismounting just after the Big White turn-off from Hwy 33 for a bite to eat. Members of St. Vincent de Paul showed up along various segments (by car!) and photographed that the riders actually did arrive at Big White! A few faithful individuals appeared at the end of the ride to welcome him home!

Kudos, congratulations and admiring, heartfelt thanks and blessings on Father Bart!!!

Another very important detail – with this effort and the immense generosity of the community,

\$20,000 – and counting! – have been raised to help keep a roof over people's heads here in this Okanagan Valley! This allows us to operate for another 5 months, helping some 40 – 50 households fend off eviction in hard times.
