PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Monday evening (June 10th, 6:30 to 7:30 pm) is our first monthly hour of prayer for vocations. We will pray for the call of God in our lives and in the lives of others. Here are four things to consider:

1. **Genuine Love.** God always calls us to ever greater love. Discerning and deepening one's vocation involves laying down one's life in some way. Though the particular call may seem unclear at first, laying down one's life in the present moment and in response to everyday needs will make the road ahead clearer over time.
2. **An increase in virtue.** So often, when we think of God's call, we begin with the gifts that we have been given, but rarely think of the virtues we are called to develop. These can include generosity, service, openness to God and others, forgiveness, selflessness, gentleness, and self-control. The joy of the saints lay not in their own strength, but God's call to them in their weakness.
3. **The need.** Scripture tells us that God calls specific people in a given time for a particular purpose. The Church's history follows a similar pattern. There are many needs in our family, Church, community and world today. Take some time to identify the needs that stand out for you or that God is using to nudge you to action.
4. **God's call through others.** God has placed us in a community for a reason. Discerning a call, or deepening that call, often requires the input of others. If our true call is at the service of others, then it is important to hear what others have to say.


Nowhere have I mentioned one's own plans and desire. These, too, are important but need to be tested. How dull life would be if each one of our lives plays out like a predictable movie plot. God often desires so much more for us than that. Maybe that is why God took time to redirect the lives of so many of his closest friends. The Bible and the Church's history are a testimony to this.




