

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

I would like to extend my/your prayerful support to all the Confirmation Candidates who will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at the 7 pm Mass this Sunday, June 3rd. I pray that each one of our 27 candidates will be "strengthened" to live their faith and to allow it to guide them in all their decisions, relationships and deeds. Those who are gifted by the Spirit, live by the Spirit—in a spirit of community, faith and love.

I would also like to offer an update regarding the work of our Refugee Committee in welcoming our new refugee family. They have been working hard, under incredibly tight time lines, to make the six bedroom house ready for occupancy. I would also like to thank all those who have contributed furniture and other items to make the house livable.

Though some members of the committee have been involved in welcoming other families, the committee has only been re-instated over the past few weeks. In all matters, including fundraising, very little actual preparation has been done since the last time we sponsored a family. I, therefore, thank them for their desire to see this happen and to take on so great a challenge. I also appeal to the rest of the parishioners, in so far as you are able, to give them your support financially or otherwise.

As I have mentioned before, a family of eleven people (6 adults, 5 children) will require a total budget of around \$70,000 to \$80,000 to support. Please consider making a donation to the work of the refugee committee by making a cheque payable to St. Charles Garnier Parish and put it into an envelope marked "Refugees". If you want to make your contribution through a pledge to the June 11th bike ride up the Pennask Summit, please do so. Let's make it happen!


