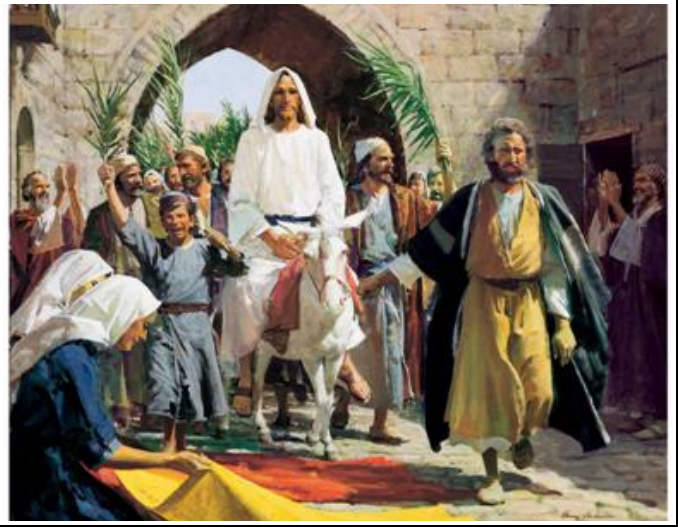

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Once a year the church offers a Retreat-type setting to allow the entire faith community to enter more deeply into the central Mystery of our faith. The Easter Triduum, beginning with Holy Thursday's commemoration of the Last Supper at 7:00 pm, invites us to contemplate the gift of the Eucharist, the Mystery of the Cross and the Divine Life that flows from the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead.

During the coming Triduum, one celebration in three parts, I urge all parishioners to carve some time out of each day to walk the journey together for the renewal of our parish in the school of discipleship.

Come and be part of the washing of the feet. Though not everyone's feet are washed, each person is asked to reflect on the part they play in this act of self-giving. Be it the mother who bathes her child or the person who is willing to help out a neighbour, each of us is invited to hear Jesus' words again: "If I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet."

Stay behind to adore Christ's presence in the Blessed Sacrament and see how we are called into communion with his gift for our sake. Come and adore the cross in response to the account of his passion on Friday and see how, through the Wood of the Cross, he has set us free.

Finally, come and celebrate the Easter Vigil and the rich symbolism of light, water and songs of praise. The Easter Vigil, unlike any other liturgy, celebrates the richness of sights and sounds the Church has to offer. It is like an exclamation point at the end of a sentence! (If you want to take home some holy water, please bring a small container).

About Grief to Grace

Grief to Grace is a four to five day psychological and spiritual journey providing safety and support for anyone who has suffered degradation or violation through physical, emotional, or sexual abuse or neglect. It is appropriate for those who have endured rape, incest, or other forms or traumatic violation in childhood, adolescences, or as an adult. It is also suitable for those who have suffered abuse by a member of the clergy. This model of care provides therapy for the soul. The program is designed to help you experience the love and support of the suffering body of Christ as you journey through the Pascal mystery of your own life.

This effective healing process combines Living Scripture with journaling, group activity and discussion, therapeutic facilitation, cognitive restructuring and grief work. It is a pilgrimage to discover the love, tenderness, belonging, safety, joy and peace that are often missing from the stories of abuse victims.

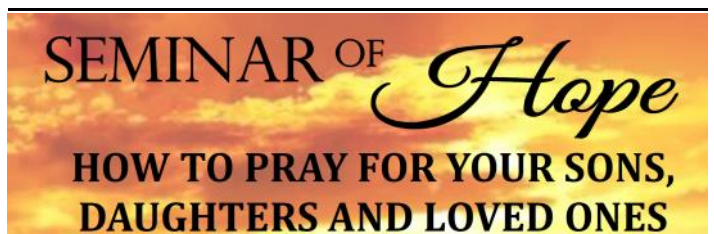

COLUMBARIUM PROJECT

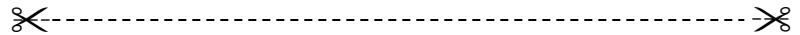
St. Charles Garnier Parish COLUMBARIUM "WHERE YOU WILL BE REMEMBERED"

Your Parish Council is exploring the possibility of constructing a columbarium on the grounds of our church.

A columbarium is a respectful, peaceful resting place for Cinerary Urns holding the remains of the cremated deceased.

The cost of a cremation niche would include the property and structure holding the urn, endowment care, one interment and recording of the process (both with the church and to comply with regulatory government requirements). Each "niche" will be identified by an engraved faceplate with the family name, christian name, date of birth and date of death of the deceased and a brief epitaph, if desired.

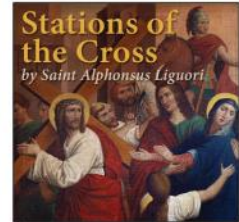
