

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

St. Charles Garnier Parish, in response to the needs in our community, and as a result of funds left to us via bequests, is supporting St. Vincent de Paul's Particular Council's Invincible Housing Strategy in the amount of \$8,000. This donation is not only meant to support a monthly budget of \$4,000 (for two months), making possible a series of one-time interventions for those who need a helping hand to stay in their present accommodations (a one-time subsidy due to unforeseen events), but it is also meant as an encouragement to build greater awareness and support among our parishioners to contribute your own funds into this worthwhile endeavour. Together we can prevent unnecessary periods of homelessness

in cases where a few hundred dollars could be the difference between having a shelter and being homeless.

St. Charles Garnier Parish's Refugee Committee has also received news that the two refugee families from Pakistan (via Thailand) that we have been trying to sponsor will now be arriving in the first week of June. Our Refugee Committee will need a team of volunteers who are willing to help settle the family. They are looking for financial support and, most importantly, they will need accommodations for a family of four and a family of seven. If you or someone you know have suitable lodging, please let us know. Older vehicles (preferably a van for the larger family) in good working order are also in need. In support of raising money and awareness for this cause, I am willing to climb the Pennask Summit on my bicycle (beginning and ending at the Parish parking Lot) in return for your support. If anyone wants to join me in the climb, and in gathering pledges of their own, they are more than welcome to do so.





Be currently in Grade 12 at a school in Kelowna and expect to graduate before the July 2018.


Plan on entering a post secondary institution in the fall of 2018 located in British Columbia.
