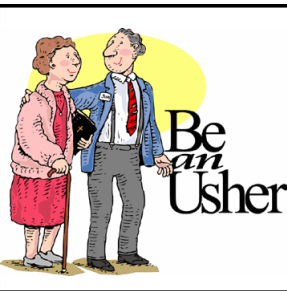

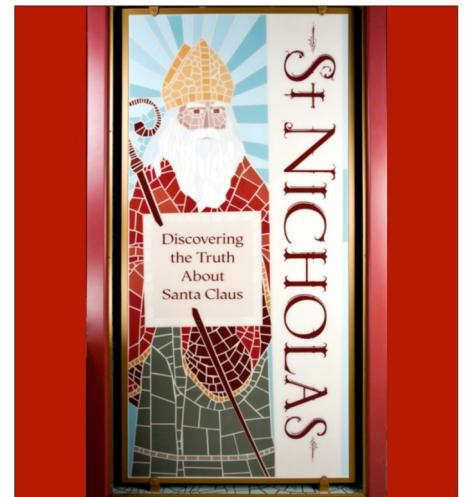
WOOL NEEDED

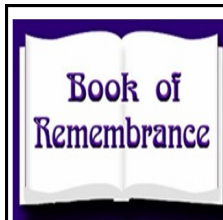
7TH ANNUAL ST. NICHOLAS PARTY

FARMERS OF THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL



The fertile farmlands of the Mission Creek delta, first farmed by Father Charles Pandosy OMI and his companions over a century and a half ago, continue to be bountiful. One only has to look at the wonderful market gardens that surround our Parish church to see this for oneself, but look a little closer at the land behind Bishop John's residence and you'll see a source of a veritable cornucopia of produce.

For the last several years a number of our Vincentians, members of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul have farmed a small section of the land to produce vegetables for donation to the Kelowna Community Food Bank. The group guided by the very able farming talent of Gerry has once again been able to deliver over three tons of fresh vegetables to the Food Bank, Saint Vincent de Paul, Rutland and our own Conference at St. Charles.

The produce list, with the number of pounds in brackets is like a Who's Who of the squash world – Pattypan squash (154), Crook Neck squash (167), Spaghetti squash (694), Acorn squash (54), Buttercup squash (183), and the champion of champions, Zucchini (5009). Runners-up in the non-squash category included Beets (265), Swiss Chard (78), and Carrots (10). One wonders if Bishop John fed the carrots to the marmots, deer, and rabbits that inhabit the back 40 acres!

Gerry's records show an average supermarket retail price for these vegetables is between \$1.00 to \$1.50 or a total purchase cost ranging from \$6,600.00 to \$10,000.00. Gerry, Bill and Dave logged a cumulative total of 133 hours of labour to achieve these results! Well done, a sentiment expressed by all those who received this wonderful food to supplement their diet!

Of special note is the contribution of Dave. Dave was one of the founding members of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul when it was aggregated in 1990 under the direction of the late Chuck Heffernan. Though Dave does not attend meetings any further, he is always willing to lend a hand at the work of the Society. Many thanks, Dave, and may we all share your commitment for years to come.

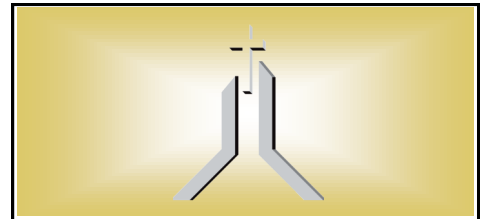

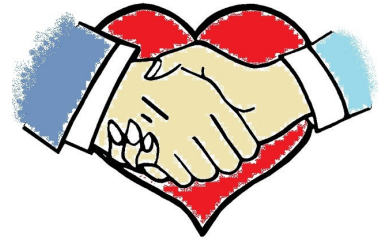
