ST. VINCENT DE PAUL GARDEN REPORT

The spring, summer and fall months have been very busy times for Vincentians Gerry Gubbels, Dave Daley, and Bill Pichach as they have laboured in our garden on the parish property behind Bishop John's house raising vegetables. All the vegetables have been picked, sorted, and transported to the Kelowna Community Food Bank for inclusion in the hampers given to those in need.

Gerry's meticulous records show that the produce included 2099 pounds of zucchini, 471 of butternut squash, 186 of buttercup squash, 120 of acorn squash, 337 of beets, and 216 of swiss chard. At an estimated retail price of \$1.00 per pound this would have a value of \$3500.00. Total time spent in the garden by our three "green thumbers" was in excess of 135 hours. Well done!

CHANGES TO THE LITURGY

It has been decided that to help with our getting used to the changes to the liturgy, that we begin this week to introduce the different postures that we are now being asked to use. I won't try to explain them here as I will guide the congregation through them during the mass.

One point I do want to make, and stress, is that when we celebrate the mass, we are acting as the one body of Christ. It is not the time for personal piety. How one chooses to pray when they come to the church on their own time is their business. But when the community gathers to celebrate the Lord's Supper, being in unity with one another is more important than one's individual need to express their respect and gratitude for what God has done for all of us.

I know that over the years we have been asked to kneel during the consecration, then stand and then kneel again. In fact I have had to develop arguments in favour of both practices as they were implemented. Which one I prefer though, doesn't matter nearly as much as whether I am doing what is asked of me by the community and therefore sharing in our unity through my actions.

If you have spent time in another diocese and they offer the mass a little differently than we do here in the Nelson Diocese, please do not make the mistake of thinking that you therefore have a choice on how you would like to express yourself here among us. Bishop John has the same authority here in our diocese as any other Bishop has in their own diocese. So when you are asked to stand, please stand. And when you are asked to sit, please sit. And when you are asked to kneel, please kneel.

I know that change is not easy for everybody but I will do my best to explain the changes as we go along. For those of you who like change, please keep the rest of us in your prayers. And above all, let us not lose our sense of humour.
