## Black and White

Attending a wedding for the first time, a little girl whispered to her mother, "Why is the bride dressed in white?"
"Because white is the color of happiness, and today is the happiest day of her life."

The child thought about this for a moment, then said, "So why is the groom wearing black?"

Sadly, after spending years in Kelowna obtaining her nursing degree, masters, and finally her doctorate, Vida is returning to Ghana to teach nurses at the University at the end of this summer. Not bad for a village girl who put herself through high school by studying at home because her parents could not afford to send her. She was accepted by Okanagan College to come and study nursing here and she received scholarships and awards for her work.

She is still very involved in Project Grow (Ghana Rural Opportunities for Women) and currently has received funding from Rotary to build a clinic (now complete) in her village but now she needs help in equipping it. Another generous group in Kelowna has given her $\$ 13,000$ to ship a container home and she hopes to use the container to ship a vehicle, medical equipment and supplies and her own things.

## Vida's needs:

Vehicle: $\quad$ Vida needs a vehicle that will be able to get her into remote villages to bring
medical services there. Her family is trying to secure a loan of $\$ 8000$ in Ghana
to help pay for this vehicle. If you know of a vehicle or can help, here are the
criteria:
Vehicle must have high clearance
4 cylinder
4 doors (at least)
2003 or newer with low kilometers
high carrying capacity
ideally small SUV, truck or van.

Supplies: any medical equipment crutches, canes scissors, bandages, vitamins
sewing machine and accessories
filing cabinets
towels, sheets
carpentry tools, gardening tools, mechanical tools
medical texts, high school math and science texts
