**NEWS FROM CATHOLIC CHRISTIAN OUTREACH MISSIONARY LINDSAY RIGBY**



**RISE UP Conference** - Held in our nation's capital, Ottawa, from December 28, 2013 to January 1, 2014, this year's Rise Up was our largest national conference to date, with over 850 young people, priests, religious and CCO staff members in attendance! The university students represented over 80 different campuses. We also had participants and special guests from the U.S., India and China.

With the theme "All that matters..." (Phil 1:18), the conference served as a fitting event to culminate CCO's 25th anniversary year. A special highlight was that Pope Francis acknowledged our gathering through a letter from the Vatican that assured us of his "spiritual closeness" during the conference. We invited each participant to sign a large scroll pledging their individual commitment to serve Christ and His Church with joy and abandonment, which will be sent back to the Holy Father in response.

We were blessed to be joined by Cardinal-elect Gérald Lacroix of Québec (pictured above), Archbishop Terrence Prendergast, SJ, of Ottawa, Archbishop Paul-André Durocher (Gatineau, CCCB President), Archbishop Brendan O'Brien (Kingston) and Bishop Marcel Dampousse (Alexandria/Cornwall), Fr. Tom Rosica, CSB, Fr. Raymond de Souza, Sr. Miriam James Heildland, SOLT, Sr. Helena Burns, DSP, and many others. Sessions in the main ballroom were broadcast online with an HD live feed. A consistent audience of 60-70 people was viewing the stream at any given time, and plenty of positive feedback was sent our way.

The New Year's Eve Banquet and Dance, with the keynote address given by Fr. Tom Rosica, CEO of Salt + Light, drew over 900 attendees. At midnight, we welcomed in the New Year celebrating God's goodness with live-band praise and worship.

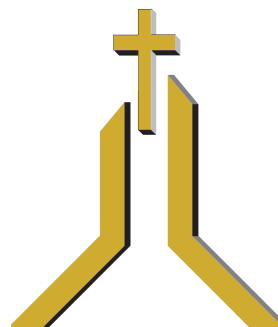

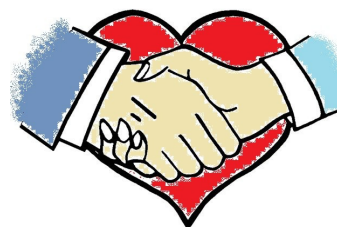
