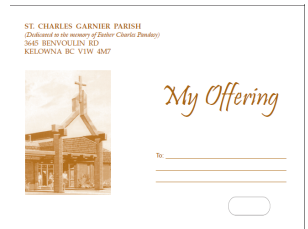
PILGRIMAGE OF FAITH

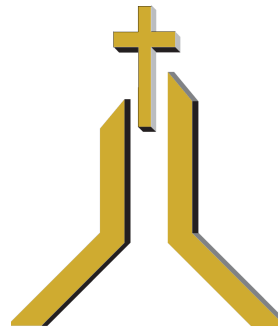

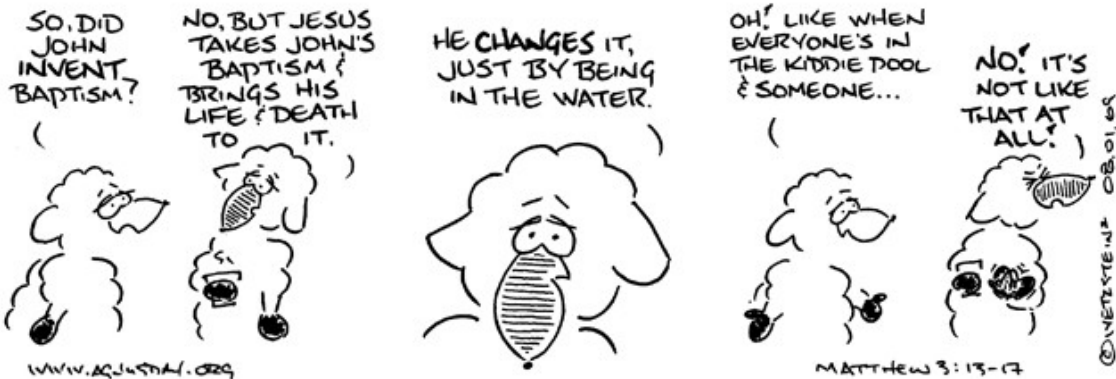
