

Message on the occasion of the National Week for Life and the Family May 11-18 2014

The Catholic Organization for Life and Family will soon join with Catholics from coast to coast in celebrating Canada's National Week for Life and the Family – observed this year beginning on Mother's Day, May 11th. Once again, we are privileged to have an opportunity to

Once again, we are privileged to have an opportunity to think more deeply about the inestimable value of human life and the role that the family plays in upholding and communicating that value. As our Holy Father recently observed: "The family is the place where we learn to love . . . the motor [that drives] the world and history." It is in the family that we first experience the love that inspires us to live for others and the joy that accompanies such living. 
