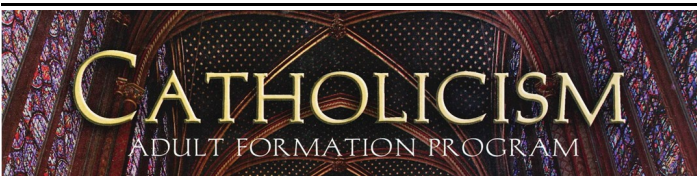

WEEK FOR LIFE AND THE FAMILY MAY 11-18

*Message on the occasion of the
National Week for Life and the Family
May 11-18 2014*

The Catholic Organization for Life and Family will soon join with Catholics from coast to coast in celebrating Canada's National Week for Life and the Family – observed this year beginning on Mother's Day, May 11th.

Once again, we are privileged to have an opportunity to think more deeply about the inestimable value of human life and the role that the family plays in upholding and communicating that value. As our Holy Father recently observed: "The family is the place where we learn to love . . . the motor [that drives] the world and history." It is in the family that we first experience the love that inspires us to live for others and the joy that accompanies such living. As the Scriptures say: "We love because he first loved us" (1 John 4:20). Jesus Christ—the "man for others"—is both the model and the source of human love and of human joy! Let us embrace his example and his love.

We all know too well that no family is perfect.
