

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

Epiphany of the Lord Jesus!

The Feast of Epiphany winds up the Solemnity of the Christmas Season. Before we wrap up Christmas decorations, the Scriptures of this Sunday invites to savior the Christmas Spirit and ruminate on what God has done for us with the Birth of Christ. 'God Changed the World' then, and God is Changing the World even today inviting us to become 'Witnesses' in our human societies, workplaces and impact the World as the Magi were able to do, some two thousand years ago. They were the first Evangelists of the Good News of the Messiah! Their curiosity was so very great which motivated them to take up a difficult and challenging journey to explore what was happening then.

From the gospel of Mathew 2:1-12 We learn that these individuals were from Persia (East/ Mesopotamia) who were from the learned priestly (class) clan, very much acquainted with the movement of the Stars. They were of the opinion that each person born in the world is represented by a Star. Therefore, they created a phrase, "Follow your Star". They followed the Star of Bethlehem / Star of Jacob & Lion of Juda (Rev 5:5) and were pleased to behold the 'Messiah, the King of the Jews' (Mt 2:2) Their enthusiasm and curiosity was so very positive & uplifting to reflect upon even today.

How does the World receive the 'Epiphany / Revelation of Christ' in our modern-day context? seems to be very much relevant for our discussion this Sunday. The Magi was joyful and curious. They had an open heart & mind to explore the unknown. But the modern world with its hidden agenda seems to be skeptical like King Herod himself. Christ's Birth challenged Herod of the past. Christ's Birth Challenges the modern-day people and its rulers too. In our context, Our Christian Presence seems to be challenging the modern consumeristic culture. People wish to find a New Name for Christmas...as Happy Holidays. If we consider the Western World as the Christian World, the Christian culture is surely and steadily (eroding) giving way to the Secularistic outlook of Christmas.

In a way, Christian presence is perceived with hostilities. For some, Christian Presence & Faith is annoying. Christian Value Systems like Birth & Death have become topics for political dialogues & discussions. The Sacredness of the Institution of Marriage is criticized everywhere, and Human Body is reduced to be a garbage, losing its dignity and honor as the creation of God.

Our Christian Principles of 'tolerance & forgiveness' are viewed as stupidity in the Authoritarian World. Christian identity is viewed with a negative eye in our pragmatic culture. King Herod was shocked, challenged, felt threatened and annoyed by the News of the Birth of Christ. He was critical, skeptical and suspicious about the Birth of Christ (as a rival King) Herod reacted very negatively with suspicion. Modern world also reacts with the same attitude of Herod. Yet Christ brought the Message of Peace & Goodwill. Today, we as Christian people, are called upon by the Church, to become Goodwill Ambassadors of Peace & Solidarity in our troubled World! Let's become the Beacon of Light!

Dear Rev. Fathers, Deacons, Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Greetings and peace in the Lord!

As you know, in December I had major surgery at Vancouver General Hospital. I am very grateful for the surgeons and the surgical team that assisted them. They preformed not one but two extensive surgeries, plus an interventional radiological treatment between the surgeries. The main neurosurgeon surgeon was very happy with the outcome, and equally me as well.

At this time, I still have many weeks of recovery ahead of me. The recovery is giving me time to reflect and appreciate all of the graces and blessing God has bestowed on me during this difficult time. I want to tell you how much I appreciate that you prayed for me. When hospitalized, during the blurry time between surgeries, praying was difficult if not impossible.
