SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

This Week's Liturgy extends a call 'to walk by faith and not by sight' (2 Cor 5;6-10) Pope Francis explained that 'We need to be walking with the Lord in order to run the race of life'. Apostle Paul was a wonderful example for our imitation who wrote in Rm 14:7 "If we live, we live for the Lord. If we die, we die for the Lord. Whether we are alive or dead, we are the Lords". We belong to the Lord. We are therefore led by the Spirit of God to do what is right and pleasing to Him. Our faith in Jesus should guide & lead us to follow the pursuit of Truth. Our walking path/road (way of life) may not be easy / smooth. There may be curves, turns & detours. Road humps may hinder/obstruct our journey, or the path may be hazardous causing challenging circumstances like unpredictable avalanches. But let us keep our eyes focused on the guidance of the Gospel of Christ, who said, 'I am the Way, Truth and Life' (Jn 14:6) It's not the physical sight but it is the spiritual insight, inner vision or enlightenment that guides our way.

Robert Frost Wrote: "The woods are lovely, dark and deep. But I have promises to keep. Miles to go before I sleep. Miles to go before I sleep". The Book of Psalms explained this concept of Walking from Ps 1& 8...that those who follow the Way of the Lord (who adhere to his principles/ordinances/guidance are like 'Trees Planted near the running streams of God. They bear fruit all through the year (whether the climatic conditions of life are favorable or otherwise) because they are supported and sustained by the streams. Like these trees planted near the running streams, we need to be planted near the running streams of faith which should sustain us and help us to persevere in our godliness. 'Walking is getting along with life with its ups & downs'.

Most humans walk by physical sight. But Christian people should be encouraged to walk by the Insightful Life that comes from faith. The letter of Hebrews 11:1 Explains faith in the following phrase: "Faith is the assurance of the things hoped for". We are encouraged to follow Christ closely & intimately and not to be carried away by the winds and waves of the world.

'The Kingdom of God is like a Mustard Seed' (Mt 13:31 & Mk 4:30-32) 'Sowing the Word of God' is Evangelization' (Preaching the Good News) The Kingdom of God sprouts and yields a harvest of plenty. The kingdom of God grows leaps and bounds, but we do not know how? It's God's grace that motivates people to follow his path (Ps 24 & 25) The Book of Judges used the 'Image of the Tree' for God's Rule (Jgs 9:15) God's Kingdom extends to all people of goodwill and branches out to the ends of the earth welcoming every people from every land & background. Every person is known for their good works (Lk 6:43-45 & Mt 7:15-19) 'Every good tree bears good fruit & the Bad tree bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree have good fruit. Are grapes gathered from thorns or figs from thistles?'. Therefore, all faith filled people engage in good works and spread the Kingdom of God through their generous heart & spirit. We are encouraged to bear good fruits through our lively participation and engagement for the Kingdom of God. All the best.


