

The Baptism of the Lord

Next week's readings: First—Isaiah 62:1-5 Second— 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 Gospel—John 2:1-12

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Christian New Life begins with Christ" (Rm 5:12-21) Christ reshapes our life through Baptism. (We give farewell to sin and create an allegiance to grace). (Gal 5:5) Apostle Paul explained this concept ...'through the Spirit, by faith, we eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. For, in Christ Jesus, neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything; the only thing that counts is faith working through Love) John the Baptist was the last and the greatest of the Prophets. Going ahead of Jesus, he preached and practiced a baptism of repentance. In the Jewish tradition, all those who transit from adolescence to adulthood had to pass through the rite of Circumcision before they are admitted to read and learn the Torah (This was the baptism ceremony according to the Jewish people) Although John recognized his own unworthiness, he obeyed Jesus in Baptizing him in the river Jordan. Therefore, Baptism is both a gift and a special Encounter with God.

For Christians, Baptism is an Incorporation into Christ and his life. We are introduced to the Christ experience. We are baptized into the Name of Christ. It's the beginning of our Christian experience. (1 Cor:10:12) From our sinfulness to the glory of the children of God (1Cor:9:20) Baptism introduces us to Christ and His Mysteries through our Union with Him.(1Thes 4:17) If we live, we live for the Lord and if we die, we die for the Lord.(Gal 2:20) It's no longer We, who live, but it is Christ who lives in us". 'We carry this baptismal mark (indelible) in our mortal bodies" (2 Cor 4:10) Baptism creates an intimate relationship with Christ. This is a unique Union which transcends earthly life, and it goes beyond the grave, promising the Eternal Life of glory. As God raised Jesus from death and made him Lord of the Universe, the baptized is given to understand that they too would be raised to glory by the power of God. Therefore, all the baptized people are encouraged to walk in the Newness of life, befitting our baptismal promises. We have become 'A New Creation in Christ' (2 Cor 5:17) and so we should be conscious of our ethical Conduct of Christian life.

Since we are grafted into Christ, like a young plant to a matured plant, we should be able to grow together with Christ!

"Baptism is anointing" (Acts 10:38) At his baptism, Jesus became the agent of God's redeeming activity. He was filled with the Spirit to move forward. In a way, baptism sets us apart to respond to God's Will joyfully even in the most challenging situations. Baptism helps us to become agents of God's Good News / Messengers /Ambassadors and Emissaries. It gives us the privilege to become the adoptive Sons & daughters of God. We become friends and families of God. Baptism gives us the grace to become heirs and coheirs with Christ, promising us Eternal Life with a Heavenly Banquet in God's Kingdom of Justice, Peace and Love. Therefore, the Church invites us to consider baptizing our children and grandchildren to experience this saving grace in their life too! All the best.


Immaculata High School would like to invite our friends and family to our major Grad fundraiser for the class of 2025! "Be Our Guest" is a community
