

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

Presentation of Baby Jesus in the Temple (o2nd February 2025)

The Feast of Presentation of Jesus in the Jerusalem Temple (Lk 2:22-40) has been an Inspiration for all Christendom from its inception. It was a Special moment in Jewish life (1 Samuel 1:24-28) and Hannah, the mother of Samuel was able to fulfill this custom as per the Mosaic prescription (Lev 12:1-8 The New Mother would be ceremonially unclean for Seven Days... & Lk 2:21 'After eight days, Jesus was Circumcised and was given the Name') In order to make it worthwhile, the New Mother was/is required to sacrifice a lamb a turtle, dove and pigeon. The families were allowed to sacrifice a lamb if possible. Otherwise, 2 pigeons or 2 turtle doves. Since the Holy Family was poor, it offered two turtle doves. The Book of Exodus 13:2 Recommended, 'all first born be Consecrated to God in a special way". (Consecration is = Presentation) The 1st born belonged to God and so the Child's parents were expected to 'Redeem = Buy back this child by paying 5 Shekels to the priest.

Presentation has been warranted by the Mosaic Law (Lev 12:1-8) Mothers needed to be purified after 40 days after giving birth to a male child. This feast is celebrated as 'Candlemas' an allusion to Simeon's words about the infant Jesus being 'light for revelation to the Gentiles' (Lk 2:32) Today we celebrate the Candlemas/Presentation of the baby Jesus in the Temple. This feast reminds us of the 2 main factors: 1. Purification of the New Mother (Mary) and 2. The Redemption of the Baby Jesus. (But Mosaic Law did not require it to take place in the Temple) It was optional for families and the Holy Family intentionally made a Pilgrimage to the Jerusalem Temple like the Mother of Samuel (Hannah) to Jerusalem Temple for this Special ceremony. According to Pope Benedict, by making a journey to Jerusalem (Pilgrimage) Jesus' earthly parents completely handed him over to God in the Temple. He was of the opinion that the Feast of the Presentation should not be a boring religious ritual, because it's deeply symbolic to point out Jesus' Divine Identity and his parents had perfectly cooperated with Jesus' Divine Mission' (Jesus of Nazareth, Infancy Narratives... Pope Benedict)

Simeon and Anna came to the Temple to meet the Lord. Simeon was prompted to speak the Wisdom of God that was in store for this child. According to the wisdom of the ancients, each child is a gift of God and they are sent into the world for a purpose.

Simeon was able to look beyond and introspect about this child. 'Looking beyond' has been understood as the wisdom / discernment... which is the Spirituality of the people who lived/live in Communion with God. A great divine light, which we call intuition, insightful vision dawns on that person to speak what God wishes to convey/express to others. Special grace/energy helps them to reveal the hidden mysteries (what would happen in the future), which the Scriptures call 'prompting of the spirit or inspiration'. (Lk 2:34) "This child is destined for the falling and rising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be opposed... and a Sword will pierce your own soul (Mary) too. Lk 2:38 Anna took the child in her hands and praised God and spoke about this Child to all who were looking for the Redemption of Jerusalem. Presentation at the temple marks the first public recognition of Jesus as the Messiah, not only for Israel but for all Nations. On this day, we are reminded by the Church to remember all those who have consecrated themselves to God's Service. All the best.

JUBILEE PRAYER




