

#### **SCRIPTURE MESSAGE**

"The Awe-Inspiring Presence of God" described in Isaiah 6:3 is worth noting this Sunday: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts, the whole earth is full of His Glory". It's the all-encompassing Presence of the deity that is called Abraham (Gen 12:1) "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing". Moses, the deliverer, was called by God (Ex 3:4 & 10) "God called him out of the bush, Moses, Moses!" He responded, 'Here I am'. Come, I will send you to Pharaoh to bring my people, the Israelites, out of Egypt. God called Jeremiah (1:4-9) when he was only a boy. "Do not say, I am only a boy", for you shall go to whom I send you". God called Samuel (1Sm3:4 & 10) "Samuel! Samuel!. Here I am! "Speak, for your servant is listening". Apostles Peter / (Simon) & Andrew were called (Mk 1:16) "Follow me and I will make you fishers of people". Evangelist Paul was called (Acts 9:4-9) "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" He asked, 'Who are you, Lord?'. I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting". The awe-inspiring Presence of the Deity creates a Reverential Fear calling us for submission.

"The Ark of the Covenant" was considered the 'Living Presence' of the Lord among the wandering Hebrews (1Sm 6:8) They were filled with wonder and amazement when they saw the Ark going before them and said, 'God as a warrior marching before our armies'. The Ark revealed the Presence of God. People tremble before the presence of the deity. Isaiah 6:5 "Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!". Jacob, who was called the father of the Israelites (Ge 33:20) when he settled in Shechem, erected an Altar and called it El- Elohe-Israel". 'Could a man see God and live?'. He expressed his sense of utter unworthiness in the presence of the Divine. God's call is something special and not all who are called are able to respond to God instantaneously like Mother Mary:.. When God asked her to be the Mother of Jesus Christ, She just answered, 'If that's what you want me to be, I am ready and willing'.(LK1:26-38) "Here am I, the servant of the Lord. Let it be with me according to your word". But as humans we all have our own shortcomings, limitations and inadequacies. Oftentimes we feel our unworthiness and wish to recommend others instead of us... 'if you please, choose someone else' or else like Moses, we doubt our ability and raise objections quoting our inadequacies...'I am a stammerer'.

Hearing God's call requires a 'deep & abiding love', a nurturing of personal time, space to allow God to interact with us. Moreover, we need an open heart and a listening ear, like St. Francis of Assisi. He heard the Word of God and responded positively. He overcame his obstacles of wealth and popularity. In order to do that, we need to have a 'Deep & Abiding Love for the Blessed Sacrament', because the Lord in the Eucharist can help us discern better and respond. Once we are determined, we are transformed, changed and renewed. We experience a turning point in our lives. According to the intensity of our love, we are transformed to become His Messengers. Saul became Paul. A man of vengeance became a friend of Christ and suffered for him all through his life and established the Churches all over the World. The one who denied Christ (I do not know him), Peter became the Leader of the College of the Apostles. 'I will not believe the resurrection of Christ', Thomas said. But this doubter became a great advocate of faith, who gave us the phrase, "My God & My Lord!". (Jn 20:28) Therefore today, the Church invites us to spend time to pray for those who may be able to respond to God's Invitation to be His hands, feet, eyes & ears. "A small step for man, a giant step for humanity", Neil Armstrong. Let's allow God to mould and use us according to His good Pleasure! All the best. In the Service of the Word! Gabriel




