

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

This Sunday, the Scriptures invite us to have a selfexamination of conscience about our 'True Happiness'. According to the World's understanding, 'true happiness' is rooted in 'wealth, health, power, influence, prestige, privilege and status' and so on. Jesus today teaches that these are illusory/temporary/ transitory. Therefore, Jesus is inviting us to 'Seek the Favor/Blessedness of God'. Worldly happiness had been coined by the Jewish culture with the above said terms and was passed on to modern culture. The readers of the Bible can easily identify such terms from Psalms, Proverbs and the Book of Revelation. There are about 37 such attributes in the New Testament and Jesus have said & explained 17 of them. The Gospel of Matthew guotes 8 of them in the Beatitudes and the Evangelist Luke has quoted 4 of them in his writings. (They are called Happiness Myths = Macarisms) Apostle Mathew being a Tax Collector and a well-educated Jewish person, he had eloquently and artistically framed them as the Character of Leadership (Christian Life).

Professor Dr. Harold Treffert from the Mental Health University of Wisconsin (USA) in an article titled, "American Fairy Tale" discusses 5 dangerous ideas that people have about 'Happiness'. 1. Happiness in things. How many unwanted things do we all have in our clasette? We accumulate/hoard them and never use them. 2. Happiness in Productivity. We wish to earn more and more but are never satisfied. We become greedy or jealous of others. 3. We wish to be Fashionable thinking that we are never going to age. We wish to be abreast of our time, circumstance and the available fashion of the time. 4. Mental Health is Happiness if we have only a few problems/challenges either health, wealth and relationship. 5. Happiness in Communicating with 'Electronic Gadgets, TV, Satellite, Computer, iPhone' and so on. We live in a Digital & Electronic Age. Therefore, he concluded the world, and its people are still searching for Happiness from material possessions & securities.

The Scriptures explain today that 'True happiness' should be found in the 'Almighty Power of God'. (Enjoy the Favour of God = Blessedness) Our happiness should come from our love for God and our Trust in His Divine Promises. Psalm 1 explains that 'True happiness comes from Keeping God's Law. Such people are said to be planted near the running streams of God, always producing good fruits and they are never tired of doing good.

Paul in Corinthians (15:12-15) advises that 'Everlasting Life in Christ' leads to Happiness. The Prophet Jeremi-(17:5-8) was powerful to affirm ah that 'True Happiness is to be found in our Faith, which is placing our Trust in Our God. Jesus in the gospel talks about Blessedness/Happiness in a paradoxical way. Blessedness in poverty (anawim of God=total submission/surrender to God) Hungering for the right things/ honorable things and not to get away from righteousness. Finally humbling ourselves in our grief and pain and especially in our persecution. Poverty leads to dependency and Scriptures call us today to remain with God, having everything but feeling as if you have nothing, because everything comes from His Loving Hands. In our powerlessness and Hopelessness, His Blessedness will be a Great Beacon of Light! All the best. In the Service of the Word! Gabriel
