

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Challenges shape us" is the theme of this Sunday. Challenge is a compelling personal demand that impels the individual for his / her soul search (selfidentification & reflection) as to who we are? Who am I? It calls for a special initiative to identify one's stand in truth. What is the uphill task in this situation / circumstance. For example, 1. Maneuvering a boat on a turbulent body of water / a flight / aircraft under the turbulent weather condition / storm or lightning. 2. Climbing a high mountain / overcoming an obstacle (break of marriage, giving up one's religious life for another style of life because of its demands) 3. Despite the challenges, keeping oneself steady and focused on the goal for a greater good is the recommendation of the Scripture this week.

Challenges shape our lives. We should not run away from challenges. We need to face them like valiants with courage and fortitude. We need to be focused on our goal (end result) and keep on pressing forward to achieve & succeed. Let's not look backward, rather we need to move forward with hope and optimism. St. Paul puts it in a better way... 'Keep on pressing forward'. One of the best ways to achieve success in life is to live in the limelight of the Divine and depend on His Providence to guide towards the success of that endeavour. Wait patiently on the Divine to lead to that victory. There's no need to grumble and criticize, because our challenges come from our allurements/ enticements (spring from our impulses/desires)

Israel had its challenges in the desert. They constantly complained about the frugal food, the scarcity of water and their lack of scanty, daily comfort in the desert. The modern world complains on a daily basis on all the matters of human life, poor health care, stock market fluctuations, unpredictable road conditions, layoffs from employment, sudden outbreak of unnamed virus, causing great concern for human existence, religious people found with double life and the so-called credible people found to be in jeopardy & etc. Jesus himself was challenged with the Glorious Messiahship, but he declined / rejected and conquered his temptations. His entire life pattern tells us that 'the Way of the Cross is the Way to Victory' i.e. struggle for an honourable existence / righteous life.

How do we handle our self-gratification? It seems to be a mind-boggling question in the modern world. Waterfront palaces, houses in the best of the cities, best of the modern-style boats, brand new vehicles and wealthy friends or celebrities in our neighbourhoods seem to be an ideal way of life for moderners. But Jesus recommends another kind of lifestyle for his believers. He himself rejected the glorious messiahship in order to become all things for all people, like a servant, he stooped down to wash the feet of His Disciples. In a way, he divested his glory and became a poor & penniless preacher. He conquered his temptations and showed us the way of living right. How do we handle certain things related to our pleasure, power, privilege and prestige, seems to be a good thought for all of us on this 1st Sunday of Lent. May the good Lord open our hearts for a real soul search on this wonderful occasion of lent.


