

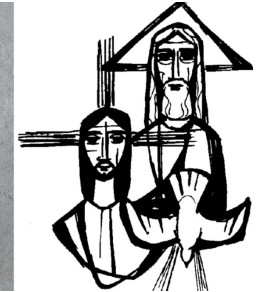
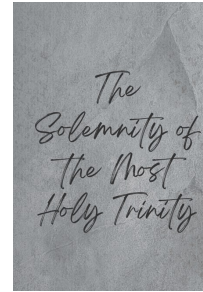

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"ONE GOD" in Three Persons! (A Mystery of Faith)
This is a great mystery, awesome and powerful to behold. FATHER is the Creator, Provider and Sustainer. The SON is the REFLECTION of the Father, who is the Savior, Redeemer and Liberator from Sin & Death. The HOLY SPIRIT is the Gift of the Father & Son, who Leads and Guides the Church. They are ONE in ESSENCE, NATURE & BEING, though distinct from the other in their relation to each other. Our Christian Faith & Spiritual Life is nourished by this Wonderful Mystery of Faith through our relationship with them. "Let the Eye of my Mind be Enlightened" Eph 1:17. 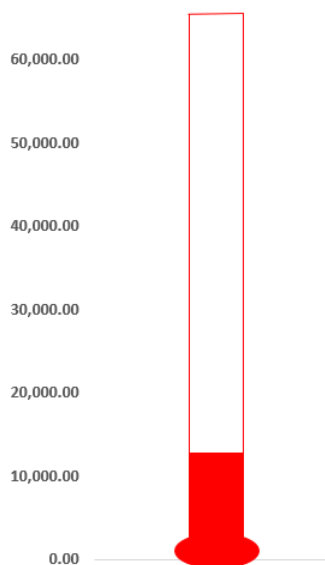

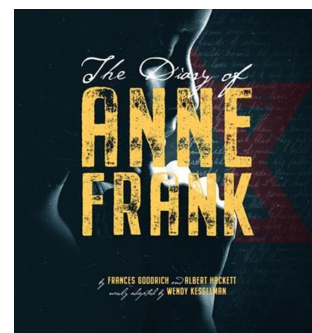

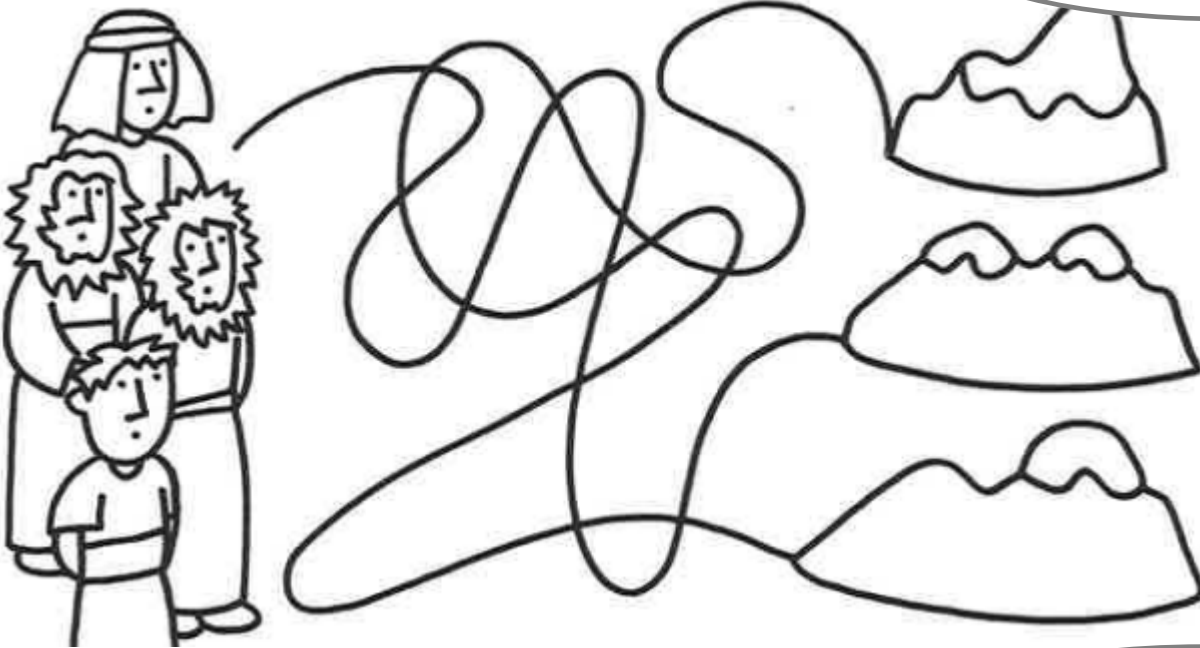
