SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Eucharist" is the Self-giving love of God in Christ! The Self-giving Love of Christ is profoundly reflected in the Statement "Do this in Remembrance of Me" (Lk 22:19 & 1 Cor 11:25) God Gifted Christ to the World at his Birth (Jn 3:16) God Established a Lasting Legacy with Humans in the Suffering & Death of His Son Jesus. This legacy is being celebrated continuously & endlessly through our Faith Life by the Celebration and Sharing of the Eucharist! The Sacred Body & Blood of Christ nourishes our Spiritual Life, and every believer is encouraged to avail and participate by sharing the Eucharistic Banquet as often as we can. This Eternal Living Bread has the power to Transform those who consume it in Faith & Love for Jesus, the Lord!

We are Spiritually transformed by eating and drinking in the Eucharistic Mystery, as in His Suffering & Death. Christ was transformed with a New Role: "Lord of the Universe" (Phil 2:9-11) "God highly exalted him and gave him the Name that is above every name. So that at the Name of Jesus, every knee should bend, and every tongue confess, that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the Glory of God the Father". By our participation in this Sacred Meal, we become the 'Image of Christ'. We are in a way crafted into his abiding love. In order to transform ourselves into the image of Christ, we are encouraged to participate in the Eucharistic Communion / Fellowship / Hospitality as often as we can. By this Celebration of the Body & Blood of Christ, the Church reminds us to be aware of our responsibility to become food for others by our 'self-sacrificing endeavors of Mercy & Compassion'.

"Eucharist is our 'New Covenant in His Blood" (1 Cor 11:23-26) Pope John Paul II Explained the 'Eucharistic Mystery' in his Encyclical Letter (Church of the Eucharist) in the following words: From page 1...

'The Eucharist Creates the Church & the Church is Created by the Eucharist'. The Eucharistic mystery celebrated at every altar, 'Do this in Remembrance of me', creates the church. Sharing the Eucharistic Meal / Banquet is a wonderful act of Remembering the Goodness of the Lord. It stimulates our faith. We give an outward expression to our inner faith. It demonstrates our deep, abiding love for the Son of God, Our Savior & Redeemer. Therefore, Christian people are called to establish this bond with Christ and motivate themselves to have communion with one another as we eat and drink the cup of the Lord.

Pope Benedict XVI explained that the 'Temple Fellowship' should be profoundly expressed in the 'Common Fellowship of the People of God in the Parish"...'fellowship of the people in the parish hall'. It helps us to build an intimate and lasting relationship with our friends & families. We welcome our new members, and it facilitates the strangers to become friends. "Jesus is the Living Bread" (Jn 6:51-59) Bethlehem is the House of Bread / House of Meat. He became food for all and invited us to become food for others by our love, timely service and nobility of heart. On this day, it would be a good thought to remember that 'Eucharist is really the Body and Blood of Christ', because in the modern world, this faith is deteriorating slowly and steadily. According to recent research, only 30% of the people believe that they receive the 'Actual Body & Blood of Christ in the Eucharist', along with His Soul and Divinity. 29% think that this bread symbolizes Christ, 10% understand that this Bread is Consecrated and another 23% say that it is their personal faith and belief that helps them to participate in this Eucharistic Table. May the good Lord Jesus open up the Eye of our Mind to understand and accept that He is the Messiah, Savior of the World!
