SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Challenges shape our lives" seems to be the message for this week. All humans have their big, small, proximate and distant challenges. Some challenges are predictable like health, emotional instability & untimely relationship issues. But some are unforeseen, unpredictable, like accidents, natural disasters like hurricanes, tornadoes, earthquakes and landslides. Certain challenges are very compelling like the break of a relationship or children running away from home or infant's death. These are difficult to endure and overcome. In recent times several Church personnel (Bishops) have been asked by the Pope to resign for reasons that are unknown to the public. The gospel of today (Mark 4.35-41) appears to be very appropriate to reflect with this background. With the multitude of storms, winds, droughts, floods and fires in the last few years, we can easily cry out with the disciples: "We are perishing." Can we be able to swim across the current?". We need to develop a 'Never quit attitude' in life to overcome our challenges.

The Church is the boat which struggles amidst the various modern-day challenges that the world offers like (same sex marriage, mutilation of reproductive organs, becoming a superman & etc.) Sometimes we begin to wonder the absence of Jesus in all these critical moral and life related questions. But the good Lord Jesus tells us "I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Mt 28:20) When persecutions threatened the Church, people felt the absence of Christ. When natural disasters occur, we all complain about God in all these challenges. When personal and professional issues mount up, we are tempted to give up our faith (we wish to abandon our faith and question the absence of God in our struggles)

"Fear not, little flock" (Mt 8:26) Jesus said, and encouraged and still he is encouraging with His Divine Presence. We become people of little faith when we suffer intensely, and we implore people to intervene on our behalf, multiplying our little faith. The Church encourages everyone to call on His Name, because Jesus has the Power to rescue us from all our tribulation, obstacles and challenges.

When Job had his trouble, he took it to the Lord in prayer (Job 38:1-4 & 8-11) God spoke to him from the storm. He stayed calm and cool headed despite the nagging attitude of his spouse who cursed him to die. Job did not panic but sought the help of the Lord in Prayer. He did not avoid the challenge even when his friends advised him to do so. He was not scared of the pain and turmoil. He did not run away from the suffering and pain that his life brought about. He was knocked down with critical words wounding his heart and soul, but he never deserted his faith in the Almighty. In his suffering he developed confidence to overcome his misery. He developed mental stability to call on God in silence. He became a fore-runner for Christ, 'the Suffering Servant' (Is 52 & 53) He was a positive man and said that the 'lord gave and he took away', why should I complain, was his resolve when he lost all his property and children. He became victorious in his suffering because God restored everything in double measure, for his wonderful integrity.

Today's Scriptures invite us to reflect on these beautiful messages offering us the hope that through challenges we are shaped, polished, renewed and become New Beings in the sight of God. Challenges bring Newness to our life, promoting growth and spirituality. Our attitudes shape our lives. Develop healthy attitudes. Make healthy and informed choices for a better life at the foot of the Cross of Christ. Let us choose the 'road less travelled by' and that will make a world of difference. 'Arise, Awake and Stop Not, till the goal is reached'. If we could come to this mindset, we will also inherit the 'Double Portion' from Christ's Bountiful Mercy!





THE BIRTHDAY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST

'The Nativity of John the Baptist' is a special Feast in the Canadian Catholic Church. His was a 'Miraculous Birth'. 
