SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"We are God's Inheritance!" is the message for this Sunday. Inheritance is the action of receiving. We receive property titles, rights, debts & obligations at the death of our beloved parents. It's also called heirship which is the exclusive succession of property rights by descent from the deceased or someone sleeping in-estate. All the Three Major World Religions (Jewish & Christianity and their people are known as Patriarchal. Muslims call themselves Patriarchal Families. Therefore, the property rights are passed on from the deceased (father or mother) to his male & female children.

Apostle Paul in 2 Cor 4:7 made it clear that "Jesus is the Treasure, We have in our Clay Vessels/Jars". (This treasure is the Faith in Christ, we have in our mortal bodies), because the Book of Genesis 2:7 "The Lord formed humans from the dust of the ground and breathed on to their nostrils the breath of life, to become human beings". Therefore, humans are God's property, because He formed us. He has given us life. He provides for us. He leads us to safety & security. He is our maker. He is our God, who loves us all unconditionally. He has adopted us as Sons & Daughters in Christ. (Holy Baptism gives us this ability to belong to Him alone) God gave us Shepherds / the Prophets to guide us & nourish us in the earlier days of history. They were selected from their people and commissioned to bring God's message to the given community (Israel) God prompted the Prophets to speak in His Name & share the message either a blessing, warning, caution or encouragement without any distortion. The Prophets became emissaries of God's gifts to the given Community.

Jesus called & commissioned the 12 Apostles (Mk 6:7-13) Jesus called them 'Friends'.

They had been given the grace and opportunity to listen to the Son of God & to walk with him every day sharing His life and His Instructions. They had been gradually introduced with a 'Special task for a Specific Purpose'. Apostles became the Emissaries/Ambassadors of God's message to His people & the World. They shared the message of Jesus' love with the people. Jesus specifically taught them 'the Love of God & Neighbor' (Mt 22: 34-40) and showed His love through the several miracles and wonders He performed in their Presence. By His Death & Resurrection, Jesus strengthened them to go around the world professing His Holy Name.

As the Israelites and the Gentiles became God's People by the preaching of the Prophets, we the moderners are Evangelized by the Apostles as per the mandate of Christ, "Go and Make Disciples". (Mt 28:19). The Apostles shared their Wealth/Treasure (Faith) which they inherited from Christ and shared it with the people and baptized them in the Holy Name of Jesus. Baptism gives us this gift (inheritance of becoming children of God) seeing God face to face while living and be with Him for all eternity in our death (Sleep in the Lord) We have become God's People/Inheritance, and our Christian calling motivates us to bring up our family in faith to share this inheritance the treasure (faith) Jesus and the Apostles have given us. Jesus has made a "New Covenant with His Blood (Rm10:9) and this covenant provides us with Eternal Life!". Hope we all will meet there some day!

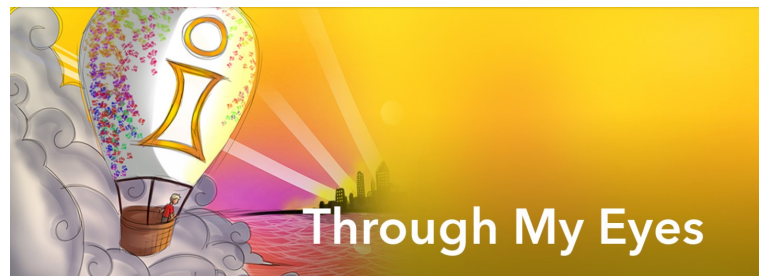
