

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"The Lord is our Justice" (Jer 23:5-6) 'The Lord will raise up for David a Righteous Branch, who will Execute Justice & Righteousness'. Justice is God's Salvific Presence among His People and with His actions & decisions He will lead his people to Justice. Prophet Jeremiah lived between (588-587 BCE) and experienced the siege of Jerusalem. Jeremiah predicted the Restoration of David's dynasty, not on political grounds but on the level of moral and religious obligation of the Covenant Relationship. "I will be your God and you will be my people" (Jer 31:31-33) This hope filled expectation has been realized in the Birth of Jesus, the Messiah, who brought life and health with Justice & Peace to the world divided by sin & hostility. Therefore, he was speaking about the Messianic King, "The Righteous Shoot" (The shoot of David) Israelites will share the Peace which the Messiah brings, because Justice is the Mercy (Compassion & Empathy) of God. This King will be called "Emmanuel (Is 7:14), God is with us". His birth will usher a new era in human history. establishing Peace & Justice.

'Jesus Brings Peace (Ephesians 2:13-18) through His Blood'. According to the OT, people were brought to the presence of God through their animal sacrifices (Ex 24:8) But in the NT, God's Children are brought near Him through the 'Covenant Sacrifice of Christ on the Cross'. Christ is the bond of Unity. He brought the Jews & Gentiles together through His Blood on the Cross (V14). By this Sacrifice Jesus brought down the walls of hostility & enmity. (Let us remember the Berlin Wall which separated the East & the West Germans from meeting) The 'Weeping Wall of Jerusalem' is a living example in our modern times. The Palestinians and the Israelite Jews gather to weep over this wall whenever occasions permit.

Even today they live in this hostility and enmity and could not come together as people of the One God who formed them as one community. We understand that 'Wall' is a symbol of hostility & separation, like that of defilements & immoralities in word, thought and action. This separation can be physical, spiritual, psychological and moral. The Jews based their morality on 'the Law' and the Gentiles based their morality on 'idol worship'. Christian people base their morality on the Principle of Love of God and neighbour. (Mt 22;32-34) The Church recommends charity towards all. Pope John XXIII, Pope Paul VI & Pope John Paul II, were great champions of World Peace. The Encyclical letter of Pope Paul Vi "Peace on Earth" is even today considered as a masterpiece, which motivated the Canadian Bishops to Inaugurate the "Development & Peace Initiative to help at home and abroad. According to this document, 'Development is the New Name for Peace & Progress. The present world situation urges us to plead for Peace! Peace and tranquility of life is challenged in the modern world due to the authoritarian rulers and those who create war & violence among citizens. Discrimination and hostilities are steadily rising higher and stronger, preventing peace initiatives. The best example is 'Haiti' and the chaos that country experiences now speak for itself. Hate speech divides the citizens, especially at the political level. The south of the border seems to be the best example of this fact with all its inflated and fabricated stories of the power-hungry politicians. We all know that 'justice can only be delayed and it can't be denied'. But as responsible citizens and faith filled people, it's our obligation to voice our grievances loud & clear to the leaders of the nations. May Jesus, who is the Prince of Peace, instill in our hearts the value of Peace, and motivate us to actualize it through our shared love and togetherness. Let us opt for the pursuit of Peace!
