SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Trust in God's Care provides Unity and Growth in the Body of Christ" is the message that we deduce from today's Scriptures. Prophet Elisha was able to feed 100 people with 20 loaves. "How can I serve this to 100 men?" was the lingering question from the assistant of the Prophet. But the Prophet insisted that those 20 barley loaves be given to the 100 men. The Prophet also predicted that they will all eat and have some left over. When the attendant served the 100 men, who ate in his presence saw that there were some leftovers. The gracious presence of Yahweh / Jehovah (The God of the Israelites) were able to multiply these loaves. The Prophet Elisha proved that the Word of God (Yahweh) has the power to multiply the loaves. The Providence of God provided for the Israelites in the wilderness for 40 years in the form of Quail & Manna (heavenly food) Psalm 145 reflected this theme that God is the Provider & Sustainer for Excellence! Paul in the letter to the Ephesians recommended 'Unity, Love & Patience' for a sustained growth in the 'Body of Christ' (Church) after the example Christ the Lord, who stooped down to wash the feet of the disciples to show them how to serve others. (Jn 13:4-5) Christ became a fantastic role model for all times through this Service of Charity & Love, acclaims the modern Church. He became a 'Suffering Servant' (Is 53:3-5) giving us the ability to bear one another's burdens, "Surely He bore our infirmities and carried our diseases; yet we considered him stricken, struck down by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities..." St. Paul is of the opinion that the Spirit of God/Christ bestows us with the ability to build bridges, promoting peace and harmony in the communities we live and interact.

The Book of Deuteronomy 6:4 Explained the "Oneness of God & Invited the Israelites to adhere to this Principle with their heart, soul, mind and strength. Therefore, Paul was able to Codify the Seven aspects of Our Christian Unity, 1. One Body, 2. One Spirit, 3. One Hope, 4. One Lord, 5. One Faith, 6. One Baptism and 7. One God & Father of all. Since God is One and His Name is One (Zechariah 14:9) The Oneness of God should be lived out in our Christian Communities through Unity & Love.

The Eucharistic Banquet is the Symbol of our shared Christian faith. Acts 2:42 & 1 Cor 11:23-25 help the Christian communities to Establish and Sustain the Christian Faith (Body of Christ) through our participation and sharing in the Eucharistic Table Fellowship. Like the broken pieces of the Eucharistic bread gathered, we the members of this broken human family are brought together by the banquet of Christ, (Eucharist) through the love and affection of the Church to experience His abiding Love for all. Eucharist is the Miracle of Abundance/Plenty. The broken bread was filled with 12 Baskets, symbolizing 12 tribes and 12 apostles of the Lamb. It's a great mystery, which builds the Church, the Assembly of God. As the baby is nourished by the mother in her womb, God's members are nourished by the ministry of the Church. Let us develop a great feeling of devotion and love for the Eucharistic Communion in our Sunday Services!

So far, we received \$ 23,791.81


Our parish goal is 30,000.00 bringing the total to: \$ 92,650.00
