#### SCRIPTURE MESSAGE


"God Intervenes in our Challenges" is the message that the scriptures would like to share with us this week. The Israelites were complaining in the wilderness about the lack of supplies like food and water to Moses. In fact, they were very appreciative of their oppressive life while they were in Egypt, where they had plenty of everything like food and comfort. But they began to grumble in the wilderness for the scarcity of food, water & comfort. People criticized Moses for having brought them into the Wilderness. When Moses shared this predicament with God, who asked him to free the Israelites from Egypt, God Intervened on behalf of the stiff necked & hard-hearted Israelites by providing them with the Heavenly food (Manna) and water from the rock, assuring His readiness to solve their challenge & predicament.

This incident helps us to understand 'God's Benevolence' whenever we have a predicament or a challenge, hurdle, obstacle in our lives. With God's assistance, we can overcome/address all our challenges, because He Intervenes on our behalf if our request is genuine. Today's Psalm (34:4) is indeed reassuring because "I sought the Lord, and He answered me, and delivered me from all my fears". The Book of Genesis 16 explains a personal incident of an Egyptian Slave girl Hagar, when she was faced with a serious crisis of mistreatment by Sarai, the wife of Abraham, she cried out to God in the wilderness when she was running away with her child Ishmael, God visited with her & intervened in her life and heard her cry. These and similar incidents motivate us to cry out to God in our poverty, hunger, sickness and especially in our physical and spiritual catastrophic infirmities. Our God is a God, who 'Sees, Hears, Listens & Helps". Our God Intervenes in our need (Ex 33:20) is reassuring.

God intervenes in our personal life and transforms/ renews us as a "New Being' in order to shine like stars, explained the letter of Paul to Ephesians 4:17:20-24. God helps us to get rid of our sinful attitudes (put off our old man), hostilities & enmities especially with our moral and spiritual failures. He helps us to renew, modify and blossom when we 'put on Christ' (follow Christian morality) with His ideals and value systems.

The Eucharist that we celebrate is the 'real spiritual nourishment ' which enhances our Spiritual Growth & Development. It is God's Intervention for us when we share this banqueting table with our minds made pure and our inner sight renewed. It Celebrates the suffering, death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus. Since we are a "New Community" redeemed by His Blood, He intervenes on our behalf assuring us in the words of Prophet Jeremiah 31:31-33 "I will be your God, and you will be my people". Whenever we share this banqueting table, Jesus stimulates our faith, We demonstrate our deep and abiding friendship with the Lord, expressing our fellowship & communion with one another, which empowers us to bear a tangible witness to Christ, through our good works and service to God's people", explained Pope Francis. May the Good Lord Jesus, intervene on our behalf when we celebrate our faith at our every Sunday & weekday Liturgies.
