SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Be Imitators of Christ" (Eph 5:1 & Phil 2:6) is a timely call for all believers to live the life of Christ, through the Church to experience the goodness of the Lord (Ps 34) Christ sacrificed his life and prayed, 'Father forgive them for they know not what they are doing'. (Lk 23:34) The goodness of the Lord Jesus is experienced, most of all in the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Forgiveness and Tolerance) When we forgive, we participate in the Nature of God, who is always moved with pity / compassion (Lk 15:20) "While he was still far off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion, he ran and put his arms around him and kissed him". The estranged son felt the heart of the father. Likewise, we should feel the Compassionate heart of God in the Sacrament of forgiveness & reconciliation.

Pope Francis & Mother Theresa are of the opinion that we get to know God better when we recognize that we are 'Sinners' & we are in need of 'Forgiveness'. In order to experience our God deeply and profoundly, we are required to experience our God in our 'inner self' by analyzing our inner conflicts & dichotomies especially through our inner joys & grace filled moments along with our inner sorrows & sinfulness. Inner conflicts and sinfulness are to be reconciled with God through reconciliation & forgiveness. 'Charity absolves multitude of sins', but Charity alone cannot absolve all our offenses'. Our mere attendance at the church alone cannot atone for our weaknesses and failures. Our voluntary works or our helping the poor alone will not merit God's loving embrace. We need to obtain Christ's forgiveness and become partakers of God's grace (2Pt 1:4) When we polish our conscience, the flow of God's Grace is abundant and all our selfless services merit God's benevolence.

Let's be moved by Him. The movement of God in our soul & life is through the Holy Spirit.

The spirit of God helps us to progress in our faith, guiding, comforting and influencing us to Bear / Produce good fruits. The spirit of God moves us deeply when we attentively read & adhere to the Scriptures. 'Every day we need to allow ourselves to be moved by the Spirit of God', recommended St. Francis of Assisi. Experiencing God in our daily lives needs to be cultivated. Psalm 34 helps us with this initiative of knowing God daily and trusting Him completely. It gives us the mindset that God is Trustworthy, Faithful, Good, Holy, Just, Unchanging, Omnipotent and Sovereign over all circumstances. We need to experience this God through our 'Human love & Christian love'. Christian love is well experienced in forgiveness and also when we rise above our pettiness to connect with those, we have challenges or difficulties.

'Hunger and Thirst' are indeed natural for all. It's a human experience. Can we avoid hunger and thirst? Of course not. Jesus uses this natural experience to 'thirst for him & hunger for him'. Our body continually craves food and drink. The same is true for our 'Spiritual Life'. We cannot just forget about God after the Sunday gathering up until next Sunday. The Eucharist helps us with our Spiritual Hunger. Loving Jesus and Living His Life of Sacrifice is a daily struggle. We obtain strength to overcome our challenges like the Prophet Elijah, who walked for 40 days to reach the Mt. Horeb. The Eucharist nourishes to walk this walk of life until our final days'. Let Jesus satisfy our deepest needs. Let's Long for Him. "Jesus I Trust in You".
