SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Be Imitators of Christ" (Eph 5:1-2) is a timely call for all believers for 'Two Great Reasons'. The first reason is the compelling World situation today. Most of the people in the world decry 'war, violence, discrimination, gender bias & etc; because of its adverse effects on the social fabric of every society. The Second reason seems to be 'One's Personal Commitment for a Honorable & Dignified Life'. All people are invested with a certain degree of tolerance and forbearance. When we do not use these personal qualities or when we fail in practicing these salient features, we get into problems and hurt feelings. Therefore, this week's Scripture is extending a call 'to imitate Christ', for creating a world community of brotherhood and sisterhood, wherein everyone is respected, loved, cared and never avoided or alienated. Jesus' role model seems to be so very thoughtful and thought-provoking.

Jesus was such an outgoing person and who taught us to 'Forgive, Accept & Accompany', not only those who love & care for us but also those who cause us challenges. The best example of 'Imitation of Christ' comes from the 'Timely Action of Pope John Paul II', whose life was attempted on by a Turkish man at St. Peter's Square on 13th May 1981. The saintly Pope falling on the lap of His Secretary said, "May God Forgive that Individual" (Muhammad Ali Acha). He was rushed to the hospital for care and the Physicians removed the bullets from the body of the Pope. When the Pope was able to move around, he chose to visit with the person who attempted on his life, sat with him for more than 30 minutes making peace with him expressing his unconditional love, like Jesus the Lord who forgave his offenders. Later in life Pope John Paul II and the man who attempted on the life of the Pope became intimate friends. Their life example is very much alive even today.

Mother Teresa of Calcutta and Nelson Mandela of South Africa also forgiven their offenders after the exemplary ideals of their mentor, Jesus Christ, the Lord!

Today's gospel (John 6:53, 60-69) Welcomes all believers who participate in the 'Eucharistic Banquet' to become the 'perfect imitators of Christ'. Jesus volunteered to forgive his offenders. We admonish our children to forgive those who hurt them, we teach our children in families to ask for forgiveness from their parents, elders and their siblings if they hurt them. We encourage couples to come together through their forgiveness and pardon one another's hurt feelings or misunderstandings. 'I am Sorry' seems to work in most of our public and private lives. This humbling experience gives us the 'greatness of heart' provided we are able to 'forgive and forget' the wrongs done to us. It also gives the mutual ability to look forward to getting along with those who hurt us.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation helps us seeking forgiveness from God for all our transgressions. Psalm 34 invites us to 'Taste and Feel the Goodness of the Lord'. Every sin is against God & Neighbour. Psalm 51 reminds: 'My sin is always before me'. We stand before the Almighty God, in need of forgiveness for all our offences. The Sacrament of Confession / Reconciliation helps us to reconcile with God & our brothers & sisters, through the ministry of the Church. In all these actions we 'Imitate Christ', by our humble submission to the Grace of God, and benefit from the unconditional love of God. Let us make an effort to maintain this spirit of 'Imitation of Christ' all through our life. All the best. In the Service of the Word!


