## SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

The 10 Commandments teach the 'Rule of Life' (Deut 4:1-2,6-8) Israel considered 'The Torah' as a 'Sacred Ordinance & a Gift of God' which should be the 'Code for Right Living'. Moses taught the Israelites to be faithful to these Principles of God. But the later Rabbis fabricated these 10 commandments with 'Do's & Don'ts. In fact, they manipulated the law and had evolved 613 Human Principles to guide the Jewish public, private and religious life. Out of which 365 positive and 248 negative aspects were born. Moses taught the Israelites to observe the 10 commandments diligently to have the blessings of God for a happy living. : "For what great nation has a God so near to it as our Lord, whenever we call to Him" (Deut 4:7) When Jesus was preaching and interacting with the Israelites, Jesus reduced these 613 Human Principles into Two Pleasant Ways of Living the Torah, namely "Love of God and Love of Neighbor" (Mt 22:37-40) He also helped them to adhere to these Principles/Commandments and warned them that any violation of these would be considered 'Defilement in the Presence of the Almighty God'.

Today's Psalm 15 Encourages God's people 'to enter into His Life' through the adherence of the Two Great Commandments quoted above. Our heart is the 'Tent' and God's Spirit is 'Dwelling' there, explained St. Paul (1 Cor 6:19) In the primitive history of Israel, they built a tent, to house the 'Ark of the Covenant' and Moses entered into this tent to Consult God (Since the Israelites believed the Ark housed God) and offered prayers. St. Paul uses the same expression in 2 Cor 5:2 to remind us of our human condition (our earthy tent = physical body of the humans, housing God). If we have followed the Two Great Commandments of Jesus, namely 'Love of God & Neighbor', even when we die, we will be still living in the presence of God...otherwise, we are considered 'defiled' and we need the mercy of God to behold His Holy Face.

The Gospel of Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23 Explains this 'defilement profoundly'. "There is nothing outside a person that going in can defile them, but the things that come out of a person are what defile them". (What goes inside from outside does not defile/ contaminate a human being. But what comes out of our mouth defiles us, because it comes from our inner self) According to William Wordsworth, the wonderful & thought-provoking Poet explained this concept as "emotions recollected in tranquility"... our simmering thoughts, hostile feelings, hatred, conspiracy, enmity, filthy language & etc; reveals our inner self/true self. Therefore, Jesus today teaches to form a 'healthy conscience & a value based lifestyle to make informed choices and decisions to make us better people in the presence of God and His people. He also teaches us that 'Religion is based on Love and not on Legalism. 'Laws are good but Love is better', teaches Pope Francis. Let love reign supreme. Let us promote Love in our interaction. Let the law guide our outlook, but 'Love should always Prevail', in our personal, public, professional and religious life.




