### SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Jesus the Great Healer" (Is 35:4-5) 'God will open the eyes of the blind. Be strong, do not fear! Here is your God. He comes to Save'. Jesus healed not only the Physical Infirmities, but also the Spiritual Ailments'. He surprised those who came to him in faith and trust. He treated everyone with great concern and humor. Jesus was never judgmental, says St. James in our 2nd reading today. In the Old Testament, we were told constantly about the stupendous acts of God on behalf of the Israelites, especially their release from slavery and care in the wilderness for 40 years. God gave them Hope despite their stubbornness of heart. In the same way Jesus gives Hope to all who look forward to God with optimism for a blessing. It may be a physical healing or spiritual nourishment or some other request/petition/ intercession.

Today's Gospel (Mk 7:31-27) Explains the "Healing Touch of Christ". Jesus laid his hands on the 'Deaf & Dumb' person. This touch of Christ is the 'Sacramental Touch'. Through the ministry of the Church, Jesus is touching millions and millions of people every day. Sacramental grace flows when we lay our hands on people in an atmosphere of blessing. The apostles laid their hands on the sick and brought the sick people to health and wellbeing. 'Cure' is the blessing we receive by the touch of Christ, irrespective of the Holiness of the Minister who touches us, because it is God who bestows grace / blessing. Jesus the Messiah has the power to heal and comfort. 'Touch is a Sacramental Gesture'. Jesus touched the eye of the blind man. He used his 'saliva' in another incident to touch. Jesus touched the 'ears' of the blind man and said, 'apheta', 'be opened'. Jesus touched him to loosen his tongue from his speech impediment.

(Most often the Baptismal Ceremony has this sacramental touch to help the baptized to listen to the Word of God) Prophet Ezekiel 34:27 Reminds; "You shall Speak & Your mouth shall be Opened".

At the cure of the "Dumb Person', the crowd got excited, amazed and wondered at the miraculous power of Christ. They were commending, 'He has done everything well'. The Book of Genesis 1:31 Reports, "God saw everything He has created and said, it was very good'. God heals and makes his children hear and speak His glory. Healing grace is 'God's benevolence to the humans. 'Deafness and other Communication related Disorders Institute' reports, there are approximately 7.5 million people suffering with speech related disorders in the modern world...who also have mental disorders. These people require rigorous speech and correctional services. The Church cautions us that 'we should never ridicule those with speech impediments. This will cause them severe damage. 'Deafness is described as hearing loss. About 62 million people over 60 years of age suffer with hearing loss. But we, as God's children, are given the ability to 'hear and speak'. The Church invites us to express / profess our faith in Jesus, loud & clear. We will be 'dumb' if we do not express our faith. We will be 'deaf', when we do not listen to "His Healing Message' of Love. In that case we will only be hearing 'sounds', but not the message of 'His Deep & Abiding Love'. All the best.




