SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Get behind me, Satan! For you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things". Mk 7:35) Jesus expressed his displeasure very strongly for Peter when he was foretelling his 'suffering & death' to his companions. Peter interjected to warn Jesus that 'such an event should never happen'. (But Jesus reprimanded him strongly with the phrase, 'Get behind me Satan') Today's Scriptures Walk us through the 'Mission of Christ, the Suffering Servant'. In the Old Testament, suffering was considered as a separation from God / Yahweh, just like the separation of spouses in modern times or parents from children and God's children from their faith.

Peter made a great confession of faith when he presumptuously answered Christ, when he asked the disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" (Mt 16:16) "You are the Messiah, the Son of God". Peter recognized him as the Messiah, but when he heard that the Messiah should suffer, he was not willing to accept suffering. The disciples of Christ recognized him as a Prophet, like Moses, Elijah or Jeremiah. In the modern world, people recognize him as a great Philosopher, Teacher and a Good Man. C.S Lewis was of the opinion, 'If Christ was not a Messiah, he should be a lunatic, trouble shooter, political activist, womanizer, friend of sinners or a penniless preacher'.

'Messiah was a humble being' (Zech 9:9) "Messiah was the anointed one" (Acts10:37) He was anointed with Spirit & Power. But he was not a warrior to be invested with prestige and authority. He was sent by God 'to perform humble service to humanity'. St. Paul in 2 Cor 8:9 describes the generous act of Our Lord Jesus Christ: From page 1...

"Though he was rich, he became poor, so that by His poverty, we might become rich". Acts 3:18 Tells us that the Messiah should be a suffering servant. Lk 24:26 Proclaims, 'It was ordained that Christ should suffer and enter into His Glory. Such a Messiah was recognized by the disciples when 'he broke the bread' (Lk 24:36)

Prophet Isaiah was the one who was able to capture this idea of the 'Suffering Servant', when he wrote his book especially chapters 50, 52 & 53 "He looked without beauty, without majesty". He was despised, rejected, a man of sorrows and familiar with suffering. He suffered for us and our sorrows he carried. He was crushed for our sins. Following the Messiah is a challenge. Lk 9:24 & Mk 8:34 Express the following sentiment: "Those who wish to follow Jesus should deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Him". Therefore, this weekend, let us ask the good Lord, Jesus, to give us the courage & optimism to take up our cross with resignation and walk with Him.

In the letter of Paul the apostle to the Romans, the biblical image pictures the Earth as a Mother, groaning as in childbirth (Rom 8:22). Francis of Assisi understood this when he referred to the Earth as our sister and our mother in his Canticle of Creatures. The times we live in show that we are not relating to the Earth as a gift from our Creator, but rather as a resource to be used.

And yet, there is hope and the expectation for a better future. To hope in a biblical context does not mean to stand still and quiet, but rather groaning, crying, and actively striving for new life amidst the struggles. Just as in childbirth, we go through a period of intense pain, but new life springs forth.


