

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

This week's Scriptures invite us to reflect on the theme of "Discipleship", which is a calling & vocation to participate in the life of the Suffering Servant, Jesus Christ. Jesus our 'High Priest' understands our suffering, weakness & sympathizes. Therefore, our Christian Discipleship is not in 'fame, name, glory, honor, status, power, influence and prestige. Our Discipleship depends on our 'Humble Service' to those who are in most need. In the World's view, people of authority & power are considered to be privileged people, because they assume / deserve respect & honor. Those who are friendly with them are considered influential and such people's association may give some credence / popularity. In Christian Sense, we are called to establish a 'Special Friendship' with the poor, marginalized, excluded, the needy, alienated, exiled, ostracized and the neglected. Through our humble service to these little ones (anawims), we merit greatness in the sight of God. The World may not recognize our Service and sometimes it might ignore our work, but God always recognizes our services.

Consider the heartwarming services of Fr. Peter Damian, working with the lepers of Morocco with bare hands or Mother Theresa Sisters cleaning the dying person / the dirty child left on the street or Margaret Bourgeois' companions helping the first nation people in Canada.... and other heroic personalities were credited with the radical concept of 'Christian Love'. Let's remember the famous phrase of Mother Theresa, 'I will not do it, but for the Love of Christ'. We are the ones who associate with the Suffering Humanity of Christ and share His Cup...'Which is His Suffering'. This may be a surprise, but this is the reality. The Ukranians, who struggle

for freedom, the Africans who are afflicted with Aids, Poverty, Hunger & Insanitation, the Asians who live with tunnel vision and mistreat other religious minorities having no religious tolerance and the hatred spreading out from some parts of the Muslim World as if the Western World is overpowering them with superiority..& etc; are a few examples of our Christian Missionaries shared for the Love of Christ. We rise far above from our hurt feelings and walk extra miles to unite with the suffering humanity of Christ, for the Love of the Lord Jesus! We wish to build bridges through the 'Bond of Charity'. (The best example is the recent visit of Pope Francis to Taiwan, Singapore & New Guinea. (Sept 2024)

Suffering is a Challenge in human life & spirit. According to Soren Kierkegaard, a Danish Philosopher, "Suffering Brings Healing"...when we unite with our suffering servant, Christ, because it becomes meritorious and we share in the pain of Christ, who suffered for humanity. Prophet Ezekiel (18:4) insists on the individual responsibility of suffering. In a way our suffering should bring healing, change & transformation, leading to conversion, a change of heart, attitude & intention. It should change one's situation and lead to a New and Better understanding. Suffering motivates us to Trust in the Almighty Power of God. Most often we are blinded by our phobia / imagination. But when we confide our pain with God / Jesus, our eyes are opened to see the reality of the situation. Suffering becomes the Best Teacher according to Greek Philosophy. Jesus learnt obedience through suffering, says the scripture.


Our Redeemer is our burden bearer. (Is 53:3) We all have our burdens. Some suffer inwardly / in silence and others externally, especially the depressed. Some




