

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"God works wonders in our lives". Sometimes he disciplines and other times he showers his blessings. This theme is reflected in our Scriptures today and especially from Psalm 126 we learn, "When the Lord restored the fortunes of Zion, we were filled with Joy". The Hebrews were taken into Babylon as slaves in 721 BC and after 70 years, they had been released by King Cyrus of Persia. When the Hebrews were returning, they said, "We went out with tears from Jerusalem and returned to our homeland with joy. This is the work of Yahweh. (Ps 126) Today's Gospel Mark 10:46-52 has a similar restoration of a Blind man, Bartimaeus, to full health / wholeness by Jesus, who told him, 'Go your way, your faith has healed you'. Therefore, today's Scriptures explain the concept of 'Faith'. What is faith? Faith is the absolute confidence in God's Power to do the unexpected/impossible the extraordinary. Faith is the extraordinary/stupendous/marvelous gift that God gives to those who believe in the almighty Power of the Divine.

Since Bartimaeus had 'Faith' in the healing touch of Christ, in a way his Spiritual Awakening Enlightenment brought him to a Newness of Life. His Eye of his heart was opened, he was enlightened. (Eph 1:18), besides his physical healing. Spiritual enlightenment makes everything New & Optimistic. We recognize the power and Glory of God in our lives. Psalm 126 reflects this beautiful insightful vision of the Hebrews, who said, "The Lord has done great things for us. We are filled with Joy". The ancient Hebrews and the Blind Man of today's Gospel did not have 'Spiritual Blindness', because they were able to perceive the goodness of the Lord in their suffering / in their disrupted lives. Today's Scripture is a call for us to reinforce our Faith in the Almighty

Power of God...Especially so, when our lives seem to be spiraling downward, and we feel that we are overwhelmed by danger and pain. We can do one of the two things. We can give either into despair or surrender to the belief that things are hopeless. Or alternatively, we can do what Bartimaeus had done in his life...'Seeking the help of the Lord Jesus'.

What is Spiritual Blindness? Spiritual blindness is not seeing God in our despair / challenge / turmoil. Spiritual blindness is not having Faith & Trust in Jesus, the Messiah, the Son of God. Those who reject Christ are spiritually blind. They choose not to accept His teachings. Such people are called 'scaffors'. (2 Pt 3:3) 'But whoever confesses that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, God abides in them and they in Him" (1 John 4:15) Spiritual blindness is not receptive to God's gifts & graces. (Unable to perceive and respond to God's promptings, especially spiritual insight or enlightenment. Bartimaeus suffered Physical Blindness, but Spiritually he was Enlightened. (The Jewish leaders of Jesus' time were spiritually blind to understand God's marvelous deeds and so they were skeptical about Jesus and executed him on the cross) The Egyptian Pharaoh of the OT also suffered spiritual & intellectual blindness. He could not recognize God's marvelous deeds through the miracles of Moses. The gift of understanding is 'enlightenment', which is the Power of the Holy Spirit. Those who are spiritually blind do not have this power of the Holy Spirit. They are led to have 'tunnel vision / one dimensional iea (do not have a broad mind). Such people 'refuse faith'. Refusal of faith leads to Spiritual Blindness. So let us ask the good Lord to open up the Eyes of our mind today! All the best.

This year's festival could be a wonderful tribute to the many cultures that are part of our parish community. Please contact JoAnn Young at:


