## **SCRIPTURE MESSAGE**

'Advent is a Season/Time of Joy', according to Pope Benedict XVI. It's an interior Joy that no suffering can snatch or take away. We carry this joy with us looking forward to the future with Hope & Confidence. We eagerly await its arrival & wish to experience the Presence of Eternity. The word 'Advent' is translated as, 'Presence, Arrival & Coming', says the Pope. We pause in silence to behold & understand this Presence. Technically the word 'advent' indicates the arrival of an official, or visit of a King, Emperor to a Province. Christian people Celebrate Advent on behalf of the 'Coming of the Divinity' for a human relationship in the Person of Christ the Messiah as a Child in the Manger. Jesus the King enters into the Poor Province called the 'earth' to have a visit with the humans. He visits us in several forms and ways all through our lives. The letter to the Hebrews 13:8 tells: "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever'.

Prophet Jeremiah 33:14-16 Predicts 'Hope' / Dawn of Messianic Era through the phrase, 'Righteous Branch' & Jesus is this righteous branch & the future King in the Davidic Dynasty who would fulfill the Covenant Promises. Israel's future would rest on the 'New Covenant and the New David' (Jer 33:19-26) and 'He is Israel's hope for the future'.(Jer 31:35-37) Righteousness is rooted in Justice, Integrity, Blameless Conduct and Impeccable Reputation. 'He is the Shoot of David' (Jer 23 5-6) 'A shoot springs up from the stock of Jesse' (Is11:1) 'I now raise my servant branch' (Zech 3:8) "Here is a man, whose name is Branch (He will rebuild the Sanctuary of Yahweh. The birth of this Ideal King is defined in 2 Samuel 7:11-16... "I will build a House" is realized in (Is 9:5-6) "A child is born for us, who is mighty God and on Him the Spirit of Yahweh rests" (Is 11:1-9) Jesus accomplishes this Hope & Promise through his birth.

Today we inaugurate the 1st Sunday of the New Liturgical Year 'C', which invites us to prepare for the Second Coming of Christ', while remembering the First Coming of Christ at Christmas. His first coming fore-told the Salvation and the second coming will be celebrated as Judge...Therefore today's Scriptures encourage us to be 'vigilant' and eagerly wait for His coming, in the mystery of incarnation. The photographer will offer private family photos for a charge.


We'll keep you abreast of developments as time goes on.



The Knight of Columbus are providing new winter jackets.


Last year your generosity provided Christmas cheer to 78 households with 125 adults and 60 children.


