SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

Mother Mary is the recipient of "Joy (Chara) & Wisdom (Sophia)". God's full flow of 'Favour' was on her. The angel greeted her with the phrase, 'Hail, full of grace" (Rejoice, so highly favoured'. (Lk 1:28) The Prophet Isaiah 62:5 Captures this imagery as a 'Bride eagerly Waiting for her Groom'. Joy comes into our life when we ponder the wonder of what God has done in our lives like Mary. Mary pondered (Lk 1:29) these angelic words with intense joy and prolonged reflection on the favour of God just bestowed upon her. (She became the mother of Jesus Christ through her Virginal Birth and the Incarnation of Jesus Christ / Son of God.

Therefore, we have every reason to rejoice, like the birth of a baby, marriage, reunion of families, christening, finding a partner and celebration of life. National victories, Olympics' successes, achievements, especially medical breakthroughs, first employment, promotion and so on boost our joy. The family joy is enhanced by pregnancy and the birth of a baby. The Book of Nehemiah 8:10 invites us to celebrate such joyous occasions with 'Wine & Food' and also share the meal with the needy. Joy becomes personal when we share the moment with the individual who is the recipient of God's favour/ grace. Joy becomes a communitarian activity when the entire community is involved. National and International Joy is contagious, because we join the entire nation / world to celebrate, like the Election of the New Pope or a National Leader.

This Sunday, which is Known as 'Rejoicing Sunday', we rejoice with the Expectant Mother of Jesus Christ, the Messiah. We share her personal joy. Joy makes the person happy, stronger and greater because it is a personal experience. When we understand the cause of Joy, we would be delighted. "Joy is the favor of God".

". It is spiritual and praiseworthy. Mary enjoyed the favor of God, because she was selected from the rest of the humankind. The Angel saluted and greeted her "Hail Full of Grace". It was not her physical charm, but her readiness that gave her the ability to accept the Invitation from God....'to become the Mother of the Redeemer'. In a way she 'Surrendered' herself fully with her body and soul to God's plan, which enhanced her to enjoy the favor of God.

Joy is the gift of the Spirit. Joy spreads to those who have Peace and quiet in their hearts. Only such people can listen to God's voice, says Pope Francis. We express our joy through our Cultural Dance, Seasonal Shouts, Unexpected Weeping or throwing things up in the air. The Israelites vibrantly expressed their Joy with Drums & Dances (Ex15 & 2 Sam 6:14-16) Today, we are happy to participate in the Maternal Joy of Mother Mary. The Letter of Paul to the Philippians 4:4-7 Invites us with the phrase "Be happy in the Lord / Rejoice in the Lord". We are invited to fill our hearts and minds with this sentiment of joy to spread the 'Peace and Joy of Christ' at this time.

DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

Last month, Elvin Hernández, a human rights investigator who works with our Honduran partner ERIC Radio-Progreso was in Canada. In Ottawa, he participated in a press conference and symposium on Canada's global role in business and human rights organized by the Canadian Network on Corporate Accountability. Before that, he stopped by in Montreal to give us an update on the Guapinol community, say hello to some of our members and share his views on our Reaping our Rights campaign.

He said, "If countries like Canada pass laws like those for due diligence, they can be instruments that help defenders, farmers or workers with tools for presenting evidence of the abuses that companies commit, that ensure [culprits] are sanctioned."

Help protect small farmers' rights. Ask Canada to adopt strong mandatory human rights and environmental due diligence (mHREDD) legislation.


