Christmas Message!

Merry Christmas! May the Holy Birth of the Messiah, Jesus, shower upon you, your family and all your near and dear ones with Joy, Peace and Prosperity. God gifts us Christ in His Birth to the World. The Letter to Titus 2:11-14 qualifies this statement: "The Grace of God has appeared, bring Salvation for all". Grace is the gratuitous gift of God. It's freely given to all, to become Sons & Daughters of Christ. Since Christ was born as a Human, we are given 'Hope' to Behold Him in our midst, honoring His Holy Birth.

An ancient Eastern Poet wrote, "Let the king and the beggar, Rich and the poor, the Learned and the illiterate" all fall on their knees and adore Him as the Lord! Luke the Evangelist in his writings (Lk 2: 1-16) beautifully presents the social condition of Joseph and Mary with the Child Jesus: 'She gave birth to her firstborn Son and wrapped Him in Swaddling Clothes and laid Him in a Manger". They were practically poor and did not have enough means to rent an inn.

Jesus might have been born in one of the caves of Bethlehem. At that time of history, Palestinian families used the caves to house their livestock's. The caves had provided privacy and also warmth to this young mother and her New Born in the company of Joseph. The Birth of Christ was first announced to the poor shepherds in their neighborhood. Shepherds in Israel at that time of the Birth of Jesus, did not have any social status and no one befriended them. They were considered to be poor and had no reputation, except that of the smell of their sheep. They had a miserable life. But God chose to reveal Himself to them first.

God had planned and arranged everything according to His master plan.

The Angel of the Lord is the wondrous Presence in Human History (Ex 40:34) He will be leading and guiding us also if we allow ourselves to be shaped and reshaped by His Grace.

The Angel tells us: (Lk 2:10-11) "I am bringing you Good News of Great Joy for all people. To you is born this day, in the City of David, a Savior, Christ the Lord!". The Angel is inviting us to behold the mystery of the Birth of Christ / Incarnation. Incarnation is the mystery of the Son of God Becoming a Human Being, like one of us. Therefore, Jesus is both God and Human. "God became a human, so that humans may become Gods" wrote St. Athanasius.

Let us fall on our knees and adore the Lord Jesus with our friends and families. Let us be touched by His gracious tenderness today and all the days of our life.

INDIGENOUS CONNECTION


A Reading from The Indigenous Version of the New Testament—John 1:21-5, 10-14

Long ago, in the time before all days, before the creation of all things, the one who is known as the Word was there face to face with the Great Spirit. This Word fully represents Creator and shows us who he is and what he is like. He has always been there from the beginning, for the Word and Creator are one and the same. Through the Word all things came into being, and not one thing exists that he did not create.

Creator's life shined out from the Word, giving light to all human beings. This is the true Light that comes to all peoples of the world and shines on everyone. The Light shines into the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it or put it out. He came into the world and even though he made all things, the world did not recognize him. 


