Dear Brothers & Sisters in the Lord!

"True Happiness" is the hallmark of a content life. It has the following essential components, a) Good Health & Wellbeing at all aspects such as Great Physical, Mental, Emotional and Spiritual Health. These are the foundational principles of happiness. b) Strong relationships with family, friends, people we work with or the connections that we form with others spending quality time with everyone. c) Sufficient Resources especially in terms of financial security for a comfortable life. All these three components facilitate a healthy and content life. When these areas are covered satisfactorily, people are more successful in their marital life, friendship and work performance. Happy people have more friends and a better support system in times of need. Therefore "True happiness" according to the World's Understanding is rooted in Wealth, Health, Power, Influence, Prestige, Privilege and Status. Jesus today teaches that these are illusory or temporary and passing or changing realities in the world.

Jesus invites us for "True Spiritual Happiness". What's true spiritual happiness? It is Enlightenment. It is a spiritual awakening. James Joyce in her Noval, 'Stephen Hero' described the adventure of the Magi who searched for the Christ Child as, "Sudden Spiritual Awakening" which impelled them to seek and find the Messiah, the Christ. This Spiritual insight is also the key to have a connection with the Divine. It can be developed by our dependency on the Divine through our chants, meditation, dance, pilgrimages, fasting, prayer, almsgiving and a contemplative way of life... Above all we are invited to experience the Divine in our everyday ordinary life by conditioning our body and soul to unite with the Divine.

One of the Key Principles to unite with the Divine is to 'Express our Gratitude' because it makes us spiritually happy, which is a deep feeling of joy and contentment, which impels us to be optimistic to get attached with the Divine.

"Worldly Happiness" is also known as "Macarisms" which come from the Jewish culture. The modern culture transformed it into Wealth, Power, Health, Influence etc". The Bible has 37 Macarisms in the NT. Jesus has quoted 17 of them and explained to his disciples. Evangelist Mathew has quoted 8 of them in the Beatitudes as the Charter of Leadership. Beatitudes are also known as the "Magna Carta of the Kingdom". 'Das Kapital' of Karl Marx was known as the Communist Manifesto. "Sermon on the Mount" by Jesus is the "Magna Carta" of our Faith in Action. The Evangelist Luke has quoted 4 of them in his writings in order to form the 'true manner of our Christian life'.

Dr. Harold Treffert from Wisconsin (US) Mental Health Institute in an article entitled, "The American Fairy Tale" discusses five dangerous ideas that people have about 'happiness'.1. Happiness in things 2.Happiness in earning more 3. To be Fashionable is happiness 4. Mental Health is happiness and 5. Happiness in communicating with Electronic Gadgets (TV, Cell Phone, Computer etc.) Therefore he concluded the people of the World are still searching for happiness from material securities.

The "True Happiness" should be found in the Almighty Power of God, explains today's Scripture. Our true happiness should come from "Our Love for God and Our Trust in His Promises". True happiness comes from keeping his commandments, explains Psalm 1. Paul in 1. Corinthians 15:12, 16-20 advises that "Everlasting Life in Christ" leads to happiness. Jeremiah, the Prophet was powerful to affirm that 'true happiness' is to be found in our faith which could help us place our Trust in God alone. Jesus is inviting us to experience this happiness through our dependence on God - We depend on God when we are Powerless & Hopeless. "His Power Strengthens me!" (2 Cor 12:10) and gives me joy and happiness which the world cannot give.

INDIGENOUS CONNECTIONS

A replica of The Witness Blanket by Carey Newman at The Kelowna Art Gallery is available for free viewing through April 10. Here's a description from the Kelowna Art Gallery website:

The Witness Blanket is a large-scale installation by artist and master carver Carey Newman, inspired by a woven blanket. The Kelowna Art Gallery is honoured to exhibit a 40-foot-long reproduction of The Witness Blanket, constructed from cedar with photographic panels to represent the original artifacts.

The Witness Blanket stands as a national monument to recognize the atrocities of the Indian residential school era, honour the children, and symbolize on-going reconciliation. The original piece is made from hundreds of items reclaimed from Indian residential school survivors and their families, band offices, churches, government, friendship centres, and other cultural organizations, which were borrowed from 77 separate sites across Canada. Each item tells a story of loss, strength, resilience, and pride.

The Witness Blanket is an exhibition based on the art of Carey Newman and was developed in collaboration with, and circulated by, the Canadian Museum for Human Rights.




