Dear sisters & Brothers in Christ!

Dorothy Day, one of the Champions of Social Justice and the Founder of the Christian Worker Movement wrote, "We can change the World, Our environment by our Love, by being Compassionate and understanding Love". G. K. Chesterton, a famous author wrote a reflection for Lk 6:27-28 'Love your enemies, do good for those who hate you, bless those who curse you and pray for those who abuse you"... 'Love of one's enemies' is a Christian ideal that has not been tried and found wanting'. It has been found difficult and left untried.

But Jesus teaches that it is a difficult task or endeav-

or, but worth trying in our World torn by enmity. Pope John Paul II actualized this Principle of Christian Love, when he was attempted on his life on the Vatican Square by Mohamud Ali Acha. Falling on his Secretary's lap, the Holy Pope pronounced that 'he forgives that individual who shot him down'. When he returned from the hospital, the Pope not only went straight to the cell of the man who performed that heinous act, but also sat with him quite some time and said that he forgives him unconditionally. He became the true example & follower of Christ the Lord! President Franklin Roosevelt during his 1945 inaugural address offered a Prayer for Our Enemies, "God help us in the battle against the rulers of darkness of the World" and in his entire life continued to pray for the rulers of darkness until his death. When people are super ugly (exploding with anger) we are hurt and upset beyond our endurance. Today's Scriptures advise 'not to explode, but be cool and calm'. Change the tense situation with our courtesy and kindness.

Don't react at all out of Love for Jesus. When you are hurt, return that situation with Courtesy. Probably this is what David was able to do for Saul, who tried to kill David out of jealousy. David did not retaliate even when he had an opportunity to kill Saul. He spared his life because David was a God-fearing man, who loved God deeply.

Let us explore the concept, who are one's enemies? Generally, those who mistreat us are considered to be our enemies. Mistreat would mean, whose behaviours are hurtful, bad or hostile towards us. "People have been naive to me or nasty to me' goes the expressions. I was treated like an outcast and second-class citizen. People feel terribly wounded and broken when their dignity and honor is not respected either because of color, dress, speech or mannerisms. We call this outrageous discrimination because it leads to showing partiality. In the 1600's the Black American people who worked in the Plantations were not allowed to speak to their fellow workers. They were treated so badly and were called 'black animals and blackies'. Even today in several parts of our world, people have hostile ideas about those who are not their own... 'not all are treated equally' is the sorry state of affairs.

"Love our Enemies" is a challenging concept in the World around, but for the Christian people and the Church 'love of our enemies ' has become the ideal of our life. Jesus taught us to love our enemies who mistreat us every day. Jesus showed us the way. By showing love to the mistreated and discriminated people in the society, Jesus was vehemently criticized as the friend of prostitutes, sinners and beggars. But Jesus never gave up. He lived out his commitment to show what Love is and specially to Love our enemies. He taught us to pray for our enemies: "Father forgive them for they do not know what they are doing" (Lk 23:42). Therefore, the Bible does not teach us to hate our enemies, rather it encourages us to step forward 'to offer an olive branch' and show them Love & Kindness.

Let us try to live this mandate of Love! Affectionately in Jesus! Gabriel




