PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers & Sisters in the Lord!

This week, We celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of Lord Jesus in the river Jordan. Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit, and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. As we enter the 'Door of the Church, the House of God, through its entrance door, we enter into a Relationship with God, through the Door of Baptism. Baptism makes us children of God. We become sons and daughters of God to share his glory as heirs and coheirs with Christ. Baptism inaugurates our Christian Initiation.

In ancient days, all devout Jews submitted themselves for a Baptism Ceremony at the beginning of their Jewish Life. Their faith life was initiated in the Observance of the Law and Conduct all through their life and existence. Their submission to the rite of baptism warranted the 'Rite of Repentance and Confession of Sins'. John the Baptist was practicing and performing this baptism at River Jordan. (John was a Qumran Monk, who practiced austerity & penance)

Jesus, being a Jew, submitted to John's Baptism at the River Jordan to begin and to attend the Synagogue to practice his Jewish life by reading and reflecting the Torah. He was initiated to follow the principles of the Law and its mandates.

Christian Baptism is called, "the washing of Regeneration and Renewal by the Holy Spirit", providing us an entrance to the Kingdom of God. Therefore, it is God's most beautiful and magnificent gift. It's a gift, grace, anointing, enlightenment, garment of immortality, bath of rebirth, seal and most precious gift to the believer. From page 1...

Christian Baptism/ Initiation helps the believer to become 'the living stone of God's Temple' (1Pt 2:4-9) Through Baptism, we become the Temple of the Holy Spirit and recipients of God's Indwelling Presence (1 Cor 6:19-20) and we begin our New Life with Christ. Therefore we are a "New Creation" (2 Cor 5:& 17)

Paul in Galatians 2:20 wrote, " I live, not I, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in this body, I live by faith, faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself up for me". We are thus transformed by the Baptismal grace.

By Baptism, we are clothed with the garment of Salvation (We put on Christ and become part and parcel of his life). We become members of his Church and friends and families with our believing community through our indelible mark, giving us the ability to cry out "Abba Father" (Rm 8:15) This is a unique union which transcends our earthly life and takes us beyond the grave to our life with Christ in His Heavenly glory. May God bless us to cherish these pleasant moments in our Community Life! Affectionately in Jesus!

#### **HOLY SPIRIT AS WIND**

### Wind is used here as a Metaphor of the Holy Spirit.

Revelation 7:1 "Four Angels holding the Four Winds" (The Four Angels having power over Fire & Water (14:18 Fire) 16:5 Water) symbolizing the destructive forces of this world and heralding the last day. The Four Winds are the 'Messengers of God' ('Angels' Ps 104:3) Using clouds as Your Chariot, You (God) advance on the wings of the Wind. ((The Angel of the Lord = God himself)

**The Hebrew word 'Ruah' serves to signify 'wind, breath and spirit'**. According to the Hebrews, 'the wind' is 'the breath of God' (Ps 104: 28-30) " When You give breath, fresh life begins & when you stop the breath, they die". "Yahweh God fashioned humans from dust and he breathed on their nostrils a breath of life" (Ge 2:7) and they became living beings. Therefore, 'breath' is the sensible



manifestation of the 'Divine Presence of Life (Power to live) God is Invisible (Jn4:24) "We worship God in Spirit and Truth". The Hebrew term 'Ruah' is therefore used to describe 'Breath=Life, Wind, Air in motion, Living power, Angelic Power & the Spirit of God.

**The Greek people used 'pneuma' to signify 'spirituality/holiness'**. 'Pneuma' also gives the following meanings such as 'wind, breath, spirit and the Spirit of God".

Therefore 'Ruah' (Hebrew) & 'Pneuma' (Greek) both refer to the Third Person of the Holy Trinity (The Holy Spirit).

1.God is Invisible. Living & Life Giving.—(Human & Spiritual) (Ps 104: 28-30)

2.God has unlimited Power and Presence. (He is in Control of everything Ps 33:13-18)

3.He lives in the Believer. (1 Cor 6:7,19-20) "Indwelling Spirit"

**4.The spirit of God is Omnipresent, making his Divine Presence.** known by the effects of his Actions (Gal 2:1-21 Jerusalem Council)

The unseen presence of the spirit leading & guiding the Church.

The Conclave/Election of the Pope.

The Synodal Processes.

## The Spirit makes His Presence known by the effects of His Actions, such as:

The wind is present when the boat's sail is full.

The Kite flies upward soaring up to the stars.

When the windmill is turning, Much the same way, the believers typically confirm that the Holy spirit is full present among them when they express their faith in action. Living harmoniously with one another maintaining peace, unity and joy for the love of God and neighbor.

## "The Wind blows wherever it pleases". (Jn 3:8) You hear its sound.

There are four winds:

Sea to the Mountain.

Mountain to Surface.

Water ways to the Land.

Dry land wind.

But you cannot tell where it comes from or where it goes" This is the way God operates:

He enters into those whom he has identified and empowers them to perform 'Stupendous Actions'. Jdgs 6:11-24 & Macc 6:8-31 Gideon & Eleazar.

He also enters into those who have been discouraged and have become like 'dry bones' Eze 37:7-10 giving them Hope & Encouragement to refresh & renew. 'The Lord causes the Four Winds to breathe life into the dry bones.

**5. The Wind cannot be seen**, but can be felt and experienced. The Wind can touch us, but we cannot touch it or gather it in a container.

We have no control over the Wind. The Holy Spirit is Unseen, but His Power can be felt and experienced. (Sacraments like Marriage & Ordination) Lk 1:51 God makes the poor, rich. The powerful, powerless overnight. He has pulled down the Princes from their thrones and exalted the lowly. The hungry are well fed with good things and the rich He sent away empty". (Reversal of fortune)

**6. Sometimes Wind can be Powerful**. Mt 8: 23-27) 'A storm broke over, so violent that the waves were breaking right over the boat:

- 1. Storms can cause huge damage. Ps 18:5-6 "The wind is also a destructive force. It is the breath of the nostrils of Yahweh", qualifying His anger which dries up the springs (Hos 13:15).
- 2. Wind is a Gentle breeze to come to the aid of those who are challenged. Ex 14:21 & 15:6 tells us about the 'East Wind' "Yahweh drove back the sea with a strong easterly wind all night and made a dry land of the sea". 1Kgs 19:13 "Yahweh met the Prophet Elijah in the Gentle breeze and consoled him at Mt. Horeb. The Holy Spirit is Powerful with His Timely Action. "By the word of Yahweh, the Heavens were made. Their whole array by the breath of His mouth". (Ps 33:6)

## **Creative Actions of God**

Ge 1:2 'The wind broods over the Waters of Chaos = the movement of the wind is the first sign of the Creative activity about to break forth.

Ps 33:6 Yahweh & his breath are Creative forces = the power by which Yahweh accomplishes an utterance, is the power felt in the wind = Wind is the carrier of God's message. Therefore, wind is a messenger. Is 30:27-28 Wind is an instrument of Yahweh's judgment.

Ge 2:7, Job 33:4 & Eccle 3: 19-**21 The breath of Yahweh is the principle of life** for all living beings. All creatures live and survive by the communication of His Spirits. Ps 104:29 Every living being dies when Yahweh takes away his breath/Spirit and it returns to Yahweh (Eccle 12:3)

The Spirit is the Mysterious Divine Impulse that moves a person to perform deeds above his/her known capacity, habits and behaviors.

1Sm 11:6-13 Saul was moved by the Spirit to deliver the city.

The Spirit is the Principle of Power. It makes someone a 'Charismatic Leader' = spontaneous. like Moses, Gideon and David (1Sm 10:10)

**The Spirit indwelling makes the believer**, 'the temple of the Holy Spirit'. (God pitching His tent in the humans) Holy Spirit taking permanent residence in the believer's heart and soul. Romans 10-9

The following expressions help to broaden our Spiritual outlook Jdgs 15:14 The Spirit rushed upon

1Chro 12:18 The Spirit clothed—Eze 11:5 The Spirit fell upon—1Sm 16:11 The Spirit departed (removing someone from the influence and guidance of the Spirit = due to wickedness/unrighteous actions.

Acts 2:2 The Pentecost Spirit fell upon the believers = the spirit began to indwell in them/ took hold of them.

Indwelling Creates a New Relationship a) New Life, New Initiatives b) We receive spiritual gifts to live and build up the body of Christ. c) It helps the believer to understand & discern to produce good fruits.

The Spirit remains with the believer until his/her death renewing, satisfying, comforting, consoling in our struggles & challenges and leads us to Eternal life. As the incense rises to the sky, our soul is lifted up to the Eternal throne of God to remain with him forever.

#### ANNOUNCEMENTS


1. Please adhere to the B.C Health Protocols while attending Church Services at St. Charles Garnier Parish.
