## **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Dear Sisters and Brothers!

"Trinity" in ordinary terms refers to "One God in Three Persons", namely Father, Son and the Spirit. It's a great mystery, powerful, awesome but cannot be comprehended fully with our limited knowledge. But we can strive to discern and understand if we are able to develop a deep love for this concept. The Book of Revelation 1:8 tells us that God is the beginning and the end ("I am the Alpha and the Omega") This Alpha & Omega appeared to Moses and revealed His Holy Name (Ex 3:14 "I am who I am") The Jews / Hebrews believed that 'they should not see God face to face & if they did see God face to face, they would die', was their belief.

But they got attached to this God and called His Name 'Elohim'. Elohim became the personal God of the Hebrews. But in the course of time, they transcribed His Name Jehovah/Yaweh, who became their personal God. They believed that Yaweh is the One who Exists (I am who I am) and He is a 'Living Being'. He is the One who created everything (He brings everything into being) "He is the Creator God. Yahweh's name appears 6700 times in the Holy Bible in total. It is Yaweh who made the Covenants. (Jer 31:31-33 Explains: "I will be your God and you will be my people" and initiates an intimate relationship with His people.

It is this personal relationship that brought forth the release of the Hebrews from the misery of the Egyptians. God organized Israel as a nation and gave them identity and stability. This election of God is solely out of His Steadfast Love ('hesed' according to Hosea) This is Yaweh's free gift to Israel. Yaweh controls history, explains Psalm 33.'Nothing escapes God's watchful eyes'. He governs everything according to his vigilance.

The Christian Theology helps us to call "God, Abba Father" (Rm 8:15) We proclaim 'His Greatness and Worship Him in Spirit and Truth' (Jn 4:24) We witness to His great Saving Actions in our life (Redemption from Sin and Death (1 Cor 15:55) 'We become His heirs and co-heirs' and begin to benefit from this natural right to Heaven (Eternal Life). We begin to understand the Nature of our 'faith'. "One God Revealed in Three Persons'. They are One in Essence. They Coexist, Coeternal and Consubstantial. They deserve our Praise. They are distinct in their actions but always act in Unity. They are Equal and Eternal.

The Fathers of the Church explained that "Holy Trinity" should be the model of our family love and life. Pope Benedict explained during the Milan Conference, June 2012 that 'all our families should be built on this Trinitarian model of love and unity'. The Holy Trinity has the shared love, unity and deep relationship. Love is steadfast and mutual. It is reciprocal and unconditional. Therefore, as we celebrate today the Feast of the Holy Trinity, let us consider forming our families on this great example of the Trinity.




