PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ!

"The Body and Blood of Christ" Creates a Unique Covenantal Relationship between God and the believer. St. John 6:53-56 Explains, "Unless you eat the Flesh of the Son of man and drink his Blood, you do not have life in you". Eucharist is a fraternal meal and it expresses our Union and Communion with one another. It manifests our Covenantal Relationship with the Divine. We are reminded by John, (6:58) "Whoever eats my Flesh and Drinks my Blood, has Eternal Life" (Jn 6:54) & Luke wrote (9:17) "All ate as much as they wanted". (But the question remains, 'do we all have a unique relationship with Christ?') It invites us for a soul search.

ArchBishop Michael J. Sheehan of the Santa Fe Archdiocese in New Mexico has done research about the attitude of people towards our Eucharistic Communion and the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. According to his study, 30% of the believers continue to believe that they receive the Actual Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist along with His Soul and Divinity. 29% of those who attend church regularly think that under the Bread and Wine, which Symbolize his Body and Blood. (According to Christ's teachings quoted above, they express their attachment to His person and to His Sacred Words). 23% of his people hold their personal faith and belief in the Body and Blood of Christ. 10% Understand that in the Consecrated Bread and Wine Jesus is present and they receive Him in faith.

St. Justin, Martyr in 155 A D explained the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist in the following way: "We do not receive the Common Bread and Common Wine, but Jesus Christ, Our Savior incarnate,

who by God's Grace (Word / Logos) took Flesh and Blood for our Salvation. When the common bread and the common wine brought forward to the Altar of Sacrifice, at the time of the offertory, Consecrated by the words of prayer, which comes from Jesus himself, ('This is My Body & This is my Blood. Do this in memory of me' (Lk 22:19 & 1 Cor 11:24-25), is transformed into His very Flesh and Blood of the Incarnate Jesus".

Jesus shed his own Blood on the Cross and accomplished our redemption.

1Pt 1:19 Tells "The sacrifice of Jesus will cleanse our moral conscience from dead works". Therefore we are reminded by the Church to 'Do this in Memory of Him' every day. The letter to the Hebrews 9:11-15 reiterates the Covenant Relationship of Jesus. Jesus has established a New Covenant in His Blood through his death on the Cross. This Covenant Relationship is Unique, because it is gratuitous and unconditional. It's born out of 'Steadfast Love' Jn 3:16 "God loved the Word so much that He sent His Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may not perish / be lost, but may have eternal life" His love is permanent, steadfast and unconditional. We have established a Covenant with our God and we need to respect and live it out with a lot of love and fervor. No turning back at any time. May the Eucharistic Lord sustain us in His Love! Affectionately in Christ!



Families from across Canada are invited to a live and virtual "Rosary for the Family".


