Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord!

I wish to invite Our Parishioners and all good-willed people to reflect on this beautiful theme "Lift up Your Holy Hands" from 1 Timothy 2:8 In the Mediterranean World 'lifting up of hands' was a normal posture of prayer. It was common among Jews and Christians as folding hands, bowing heads, closing eyes, keeling down & etc.; 1Kgs 8:54 "Solomon rose from where he was kneeling with hands stretched out towards heaven before the Altar and stood erect".

'Lifting up of hands' is a Universal sign of Surrender. When we come to God in Worship - 'lifting our hands is a physical demonstration of our surrender in our heart and mind to His Lordship, Christ! "All beings in the Heavens, on earth and in the underworld, should bend the knee at the Name of Jesus and that every Tongue should acclaim Jesus as Lord!" (Phil 2: 10) Lifting up of our hands is also a form of supplication. Like a person drowning in water (Ps 68: 1-2) "Save me God! The water is already up to my neck! I am sinking in the deepest swamp, there is no foothold; I have stepped into deep water and the waves are washing over me". We lift our hands to be saved. In war, when we lift our hands, we surrender to the enemy allowing us into captivity and humiliation. When we lift our hands in prayer, we 'surrender to god for freedom to be raised up to live life to the full'.

Therefore 'lifting up of Hands is an act of the Will'. Lifting up of the Heart as the centre of affection - that prompts the outward act of the hands of supplication. We are weak people and without any power outside of God. When we are desperate, we lift up our hands in prayer surrendering to God asking Him to empower us. 1 Pt 2:9 Tells, 'You are a chosen race,

a royal priesthood, a consecrated nation, a people set apart, to sing the praises of God who called you out of the darkness into His wonderful light". When we lift our hands, we exercise our priestly function - by raising our hands to call on the Name of the Lord! (Ps 18:6) "In my distress I called God, and cried. From His Temple he heard my voice, my cry came to His ears".

We wish to raise our hands in supplication on behalf of our sisters and brothers in Ukraine for the coming Seven Sundays of Lent. During our Sunday assembly we wish to plead with our uplifted hands to God Our Father...as the Ukrainian's are in great distress/ they are in deep waters. Through our sharing of their pain and suffering we would like to raise our Holy hands in Prayer, which is a devoted act of surrender and service to the Lord at this time. This is a profound gesture of prayer.

Ps 141:2 Encourages "Let my prayer be counted as incense before you, and lifting of my hands as the evening sacrifice". Ps 143;6 "I thirst for you as a parched land thirsts for rain". Probably this is what Russians will also be praying for, because 'peace is disrupted and they thirst for peace. On their behalf and on behalf of the whole human race we would like to raise our holy hands and surrender to the Lord with our challenges. Be sure and certain, 'the Lord hears the cry of the poor' (Ps 103:8) Join our Congregation with 'uplifted Hands during the Prayer of Our Father'. Let us bring healing and comfort in the troubled parts of the World.




