Dear Brothers & sisters in Christ the Lord!

The Gospel of Luke 9:36 extends an invitation this Sunday to "Listen to Jesus". Jesus speaks to us every day. Our conscience tells us that He is always telling us that we are His Children. The Word of God speaks to us of His pleasant & beautiful words encouraging to establish a bond with Him. From time immemorial people have been listening to His gracious words and His words have transformed so many of our predecessors who have become the stalwarts of our Christian Heritage, and we call them saints. Since St. Paul calls all of us Saints (1 Cor 1:2), we have this great opportunity to hear and transform our lives by Listening & transforming our lives after the model of his disciples.

The 2nd Sunday of Lent explores the possibility of the 'Supreme Importance of Listening". Benjamin Franklin one of the famous architects of the American Constitution wrote: "Reading makes a Ready man. Listening makes an Informed man and Writing makes an Exact man". Reading and reflection of the Scriptures therefore makes us informed of God's mighty acts of love and helps us transform our lives for the better.

Lent offers a time of Listening like the first disciples of Christ. John 1:38-39 explains that when the first disciples Andrew & James met Jesus, John the Baptist pointed to Jesus and said, "Look here is the Lamb of God". Jesus turned round and saw them following him, he asked, "What do you want?'. They replied, Rabbi, "Where do you live?". Jesus said, "Come and See". They went and saw where Jesus lived and stayed with him. They listened to him and never left him thereafter.

Like the First Disciples of Christ, we are given a chance to 'Seek & find the Lord by our listening'.

Listening leads to a Transforming Spiritual Encounter, Intimacy & Experience'. It gives access to have a deep friendship and intimacy with Christ for those who Seek Him with a Sincere heart. Listening is an important skill in developing and maintaining relationships. Oftentimes, we are only selective listeners. Today's scriptures invite us to engage in purposeful listening...'listen with our mind & heart / soul'.

Jesus was an Active Listener! 1) He listened to everyone actively, i.e 'without prejudice' but with 'great love' (Example: Lk 19; 1-10 the story of Zaccheus) When we are interested in them, we listen attentively with eye contact & empathy. 2) Jesus oftentimes asked questions to get to know them and get acquainted with their challenges or joys (Example Lk 8:40-56) He was willing to inquire into their personal life to help them. 3) Jesus was a role model for Engagement. He engaged people and ministered to them according to their requirement. 4) Jesus was always available to listen. He never missed an opportunity or pretended to be busy. He spared quality time for everyone who came to him. 5) Jesus always had a Nudge to His Heavenly Father. (MK 1:35)"He got up early and went off to a lonely place and prayed there", and He Nudges us to Listen to Him (Mt 15:10) He called people and said, "Listen & Understand".

Therefore James 1:19 tells, "To be quick to listen and slow to speak". Today's scripture is a call to become an Intentional Listener/ to be truly interested to listen and understand. Jesus cared for his people and disciples. He was able to create a bond / relationship by listening and influenced them greatly. As a church and members of Christ's body, we are called to listen to others and understand them not only with our ears but also with our heart, soul and mind. May the good Lord guide us in this pursuit.

Do you enjoy learning about other cultures? Do you like kids? Do you have a spare room?




