Dear Brothers & Sisters in the Lord!

"Christian Calling" is a wonderful privilege to be friends with Christ the Lord! Saint Therese of the Little Flower explained this 'Calling in Christ is Love". She always nurtured this spirit that God called her to Love. She wrote, "In the heart of the Church, my vocation / calling is Love". She lived out this Christian mandate in a special way, which amazed everyone. Though she suffered tuberculosis most part of her life, she did not give up this ideal of love. In fact, she radiated the love of God and the joy of Christ despite her hurdles. The greater she suffered the deeper she loved Christ and became an intimate friend of Christ, radiating His allencompassing love.

Christian Movement is predominantly based on love. This movement originates from God. Acts 5:28 -41 explains that God commissioned the Apostles to spread this movement around the world. For the past 2000 years the opponents of this movement have been trying their best to discredit it with tooth and nail. Acts of the Apostles 5:36-37 attests, "If this movement is not from God's initiative, it will perish by itself". Since it is from God, it still stands gloriously, proclaiming the message of God's love loud and clear, despite the obstacles faced.

Christian Calling is a free gift extended to all people of goodwill. It is a blessing gratuitously given. Whosoever responds to this invitation of God are becoming members of Christ's Body, the Church, through their Christian Initiation. The Christian initiation centres around the apostolic preaching consisting of the 'Christ Event'. that is the Suffering, Death and Resurrection of Christ. Rom 8:28-30

explained the 'Call of people according to God's Purpose', that is, 'to become His Sons and Daughters'. Then He bestows gifts and graces as our earthly parents do, and nurtures us to become the 'Image of His Son Jesus'. (To love everyone unconditionally like Jesus).

Our Christian life is based on the value system of Love & Service leading us towards the goal of reaching Heaven, through right living, (Mt 25:3-46 elaborately discusses this requirement) and treating everyone with respect, dignity and honor, without any judgement. Our Christian life is not based on 'status & power' but it is based on 'goodwill & common good'. We are encouraged to make a difference and to walk extra miles to make Christ known through our acts of charity. Our Christian Mission is based on the Principle of the Commandment of Love. John 13:34 "Love one another as I have loved you". Our Christian responsibility is therefore to make Christ available through our presence and our generous fellowship without any discrimination, as all are children of God.

Therefore, our Christian calling has its foundation in Jesus himself. He is inviting us 'to be planted and rooted in His Love' (Col 2:6) so that we may grow and bear good fruits for His Mighty Love!... (Mt 7:16-18)


