"Peace is the Gift of Christ" Jn 14:27 "Christ is Our Peace" Eph 2:14 "Let the Peace of Christ Reign in your hearts" Col 3:15 Peace is Spiritual Tranquility that Christ gives, which has no resemblance to what the World gives. The World is corrupt. People quarrel, hurt, carry on violence, war and terrorize, but we are called to love, Forgive and Transform those who engage in denying the Peace of the World. (The ready example in the modern world is the Russian Dictator who has caused so much of havoc in the ordinary everyday life of the people around, to achieve his selfish ends)

Peace of God differs from the peace of the World. 

Therefore, let us humbly invoke the Prince of peace, to instill this great ideal of Peace in our human world, so that we may be able to live and let live everyone harmoniously despite the challenges we face. May Christ the Lord Lead & Guide us in this pursuit.



Families from across Canada are invited to a live and virtual "Rosary for the Family".






