PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ!

This Sunday, we celebrate 'Good Shepherd Sunday' in honor of Jesus, the 'True Shepherd'. Shepherds tend their sheep. Tending is caring / looking after their sheep...by providing green pastures, rescuing them from enemies, helping them to be with the herd all the time. Jesus had a timely conversation with Peter, the Chief Apostle, instructing him how he could exercise his leadership role. Jesus asked Peter: Simon son of John, "Do you love me more than these?". Peter answered, "Yes, I love you". Then Jesus said: "Feed my Lambs, look after my Sheep & Feed my Sheep". By repeating again and again Jesus made it clear the Apostles are to become the Shepherds of God's people, and their prime duty or responsibility is tending / caring for the sheep, which is nourishing the faithful by the Divine Word, Example and Sacraments.

Shepherds are God's chosen vessels / instruments, and they are charged with the commission of responsibility. They have become the legitimate owners of the sheep. In fact, shepherds are the mouthpiece of God. They fulfill the Threefold functions of 'Priest, Prophet and King'. The true shepherd knows His Sheep and calls them by their name. Shepherds are commissioned 'to build up the Christian Communities' so that they may be able to live a dignified life personally and become a role model in the society in which they live. So shepherds should have a real reputation in the society in which they live and their rapport should not be strained. If they are not people of integrity & credibility, they will corrupt their community and destroy their spirituality.

Shepherds are called to be 'prudent managers of God's Vineyard, the Church'. Jesus uses the beautiful expression that the shepherds should be abreast and diligent gate keepers of their fold, so that the people may have easy access to have their concerns addressed in a timely manner. True and Genuine Shepherds lead the flock to green pastures. The Spiritual life of the community is nourished and vitalized through their life and example. They help their communities through their continuous caring and taking part in their joys & challenges. Pope Francis explained in the Joy of the Gospel, "To Smell the Sheep & Go to the Pheriperies" to be nearer to them whenever they are in need.

His Holiness Pope John Paul II explained that all people are called to be Good Shepherds. Our common heritage is the 'Holiness of life. Whether we are parent, pastor or leader, or an individual person, we all have a role to play and that role is our lifelong commitment to God and to our people. Whatever we do and say should be able to build up and not tear it down. Our spirituality should be able to help to have a loving & respectable relationship with everyone, even those with whom we have some challenges or hurt feelings. We are all children of God and we need to minister to one another. Therefore, let us develop a personal and interpersonal relationship to express our love and care of others imitating the Good Shepherd Jesus!




