Scripture Message:

"If anyone is in Christ, there is New Creation" (2 Cor 5:17) Christians are the New Israel of God (1Cor 10:1-6,10-12) because, we are redeemed by Christ through His Death and Resurrection as Moses was able to help the release of the Hebrews from the slavery of the Egyptians through the Waters of the Red Sea. God intervened on behalf of the Hebrews to open the Red Sea helping them pass through its waters under 'His Cloud' (Presence). Our Christian 'Baptism and Eucharist' are the very outcome of this release of our ancient Hebrew sisters and brothers. They had been liberated through the 'Waters of the Red Sea'. Our Christian Communities and their people are saved through the Baptismal Waters of Rebirth/ Regeneration/Renewal.

The Hebrews celebrated 'Passover Meal' before their release from Egyptian tyranny. Christian people Celebrate the 'Last Supper' as the remembrance of what God in Christ has done for 'Our Release from Sin and Death'. In every Eucharistic Celebration, we remember:

"What Christ has done through His Suffering, Death & Resurrection". Through Baptism we become the Children of God. It is God's pure grace and gift as it has been recorded in Galatians 3:16-19 (For if the inheritance comes from the law, it no longer comes from the promise, but God granted it to Abraham through the promise. Now the Offspring had come (Jesus Christ = Redeemer) to whom the Promise had been made. Like the Hebrews who became God's people through Abraham, We, the Christian people become heirs and co-heirs with Christ because of the Promise and the Celebration of our Rebirth through Water & Spirit.

God's Presence was spread over the Hebrews by the 'Cloud' narrates the Book of Numbers 9:21) Even now God spreads His Cloud through 'His Spirit' over us narrates (Psalm 105:39) The Spirit is the operating Principle in the Church which guides the Church and its initiatives through His

Abiding Presence.


